Chicken Bacon Ranch Casserole

6 slices bacon, chopped

1 small onion, chopped

4 cloves garlic, finely chopped

8 oz. cream cheese, cubed

2 c. milk

1 1 oz. packet dry ranch seasoning mix

3 c. shredded mozzarella cheese, divided

8 oz. rotini pasta, cooked
4 c. chopped rotisserie chicken
4 oz. diced pimientos, drained
1/2 c. sliced green onion, plus more for garnish

Preheat the oven to 375°F. In a 12-inch skillet, cook the bacon over medium heat, stirring often until crispy, about 8 minutes. Remove the bacon from the pan. Set aside, leaving drippings in pan. Add the onion and garlic to the drippings; cook, stirring often, until slightly softened, about 5 minutes. Whisk in the cream cheese, milk, ranch seasoning mix, and 1 cup of the mozzarella until smooth; remove from the heat. In a large bowl, stir together the ranch mixture, cooked pasta, chicken, pimientos, and 1/2 cup of the green onion until well combined. Transfer to a 13x9-inch casserole dish. Sprinkle evenly with the bacon; top with the remaining 2 cups mozzarella. Bake until the top is golden brown and crispy, 25-30 minutes. Garnish with green onion.
