Old-Fashioned Vegetable Beef Soup

1 lb beef stew meat

1 onion

3 celery ribs

10 baby carrots (or a couple regular carrots)

2 potatoes (peeled if you like)

1 cup frozen corn

- 1 cup frozen peas
- 2 (14 ounce) cans diced tomatoes
- 3 1/2 cups beef broth
- 2 small bay leaves
- 2 teaspoons garlic powder
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 4 cups water

Cut meat into small, bite-size (1/2") pieces. In a large pot, saute meat in 1 T oil on medium-high heat until all sides are brown. Set aside on a plate. Chop celery, onion, potatoes, and carrots into bite-size pieces. Saute celery and onion in remaining 1 T oil until onion is golden (about 10 minutes). Add browned beef, water, broth, tomatoes with juices, carrots, potatoes, corn, bay leaves and garlic. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer uncovered until beef is almost tender, about an hour. Add peas. Cover and simmer until beef is tender.
