Update from Sr. Janice: I feel so supported by your other prayers, cards, and kindnesses. you!! Recovery is going very well. After receiving many broken bones in a serious car accident on Nov. 9th I wore a sling on my left arm and a neck brace for seven weeks, and I walked with a cane. The sling, brace, and cane are gone now. I can walk over a mile a day and I'm doing therapy for range of motion on my neck and arm. The care at Holy Spirit assisted living in Sioux City has been excellent. On Saturday, Feb. 4th I moved temporarily to be with our Sisters at Clare House, 3340 Windsor Avenue, Dubuque, IA 52001. When I'm well enough I plan to return to live in Cherokee. It will be good to see you again.

Help us help you. When you are admitted to the hospital, the main focus of the staff is on your physical health and they sometimes forget to ask about your spiritual needs. You or a family member need to make sure your nurse knows you want to receive Communion. Once they know you want Communion, you are put on the "yes" list and when the Eucharistic Ministers call the hospital, your name can be given to them.

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LiHEAP) offered through Mid-Sioux Opportunity, Inc. may be able to help you pay your winter heating bill. This program is funded through the Iowa Department of Human Rights and has been established to help qualified low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs. Your local Mid-Sioux office will be taking applications through April 30, 2023. Call 225-3322 for an appointment to apply for LiHEAP.



#### **Tater Tot Casserole**

1 pound ground beef1 medium onion (chopped)1 can cream of mushroom soup

 $3 \frac{1}{2}$  cups frozen mixed vegetables

1 tbsp ketchup

1 tbsp Worcestershire sauce

3 cups frozen tater tots

2 cups shredded cheddar cheese

In a large skillet, cook the beef and onion over mediumhigh heat until the beef is fully browned. Break up the meat as it cooks. Drain off excess liquid. In a large bowl mix together the beef mixture with the soup, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce, frozen mixed vegetables, and 1 cup of the shredded cheese. Transfer the mixture to a 12×8-inch shallow baking dish. Top the beef with tater tots. Bake at 425 degrees F for 20 minutes. Top the casserole with shredded cheese and bake for 5 additional minutes until the cheese is melted.
