Last year's Appeal raised a record amount which meant that even more could be done for people in our local Church of Paterson. • SCHOOL SUPPORT

With the help of the Bishop's Annual Appeal last year, much was done to support Catholic schools in the inner-city area, including capital improvements such as roof replacement, HVAC upgrades, interior lighting and exterior doors. The Appeal also helped fund financial aid to assist families to afford Catholic school education, technology upgrades to enhance the academic programs offered in the schools and support of school activities such as music, art and sports that give a well-rounded educational experience.

• SEMINARIAN EDUCATION AND OUR DIOCESAN PRIESTS' RETIREMENT RESIDENCE

The Bishop's Annual Appeal helps fund the education of our seminarians and Nazareth Village, our diocesan priests' retirement residence in Chester. This is especially important since the number of seminarians has increased dramatically in recent years, along with the cost of their formation. The Appeal helps both of these groups of men: those who are preparing for a lifetime of service to the Church and those who have faithfully served for decades.

• PARISH REBATES

Half of the amount received over our parish goal will be returned to our parish for our own needs. Not only does the Appeal

support many worthwhile ministries throughout the diocese, it will also help our own parish if we reach and exceed our goal.

96 cents of every dollar raised is applied to the Appeal needs as outlined above. The 4 cent balance for fundraising expenses is far below the guidelines recommended by the Better Business Bureau Wise Giving Alliance.

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

Our new Faith Formation Year is upon us. Thank you to all of the parents who entrust your children to our Faith Formation Program. It is a privilege to assist you as you hand on the gift of faith to your children. If you have not already done so, please register your children for our Faith Formation programs which begin this month. It is important that all registrations are in ASAP to ensure our ability to adequately plan for your children's sessions.

For parents who have registered, you will receive notification by mail (US Postal Service) a week prior to your child/children beginning that will outline important information for the start of the year, including the name of your child/children's catechist as well as room assignment. Please read this letter and any enclosed documents in their entirety.

OUR PARISH HERITAGE CAMPAIGN

We are now well underway in our "Heritage Campaign" which we are embarking upon in order to continue moving forward with our care for our church building which speaks to the living heritage that is our faith. Thank you for your characteristic generosity that has set our parish family on the path to another successful parish campaign. On the weekend of May 18th, I spoke at all of the Sunday Masses in order to encourage your participation in this exciting campaign and already the response has been in keeping with your characteristic generosity. As always, I thank you profoundly. Thank you for always coming to the support of our parish so that we are able to continue sustaining our firm foundation for the future. The bell was due to be reinstalled on the church roof this Thursday; there remains more work until the bell is functional and the work is complete.

The preparatory work on restoring the bell to the church roof is complete. The architect is drawing up the plans for the proper housing for the bell base before it is placed back atop the church. In time, the bell will be sent to be re-outfitted so that it will once again ring. A new mechanism is required to make the bell functional again since the old motor burned out long ago. The bell has been taken for cleaning, polishing, and for the installation of a new motor. As you can see, work on the awning is progressing week by week. Hopefully, you have noticed the photos of the new lighting that makes our church such a welcoming presence and a sign of God's love.

Another mailing was recently sent to provide an opportunity for those who have not yet participated in this exciting project for our parish to give thoughtful prayer and consideration to making a contribution. The Letter is reprinted here:

Today is the Feast of Our Lady of the Holy Angels. The Church of Saint Mary of the Angels stands in Assisi, home of Saint Francis, who took to heart the Lord's message: "Rebuild my church." The large church of Saint Mary of the Angels houses the much smaller church that Saint Francis literally tried to repair with his own hands. On this Feast of Our Lady of the Holy Angels, I commend you to her care and pray that she will intercede for you and for all those whom you love.

Important Message to Parents

Dismissal is from church following 5:00 mass, which is the most integral part of your child's session, and therefore their consistent attendance is required. Parents are encouraged to join us for mass. Meet us at 4:45 in St. Francis Hall.

September 29th: Grades 1-4

We begin at 2:00 PM IN CHURCH with mass, at which parents are expected to attend WITH their children. Attendance will be taken in church. Children will transition as a class to their rooms following mass. Parents can walk with them to class. Dismissal will be at 4:15 from class. Once buildings are unlocked at 4:15, parents should go to their child's class and check their child out with the catechist.

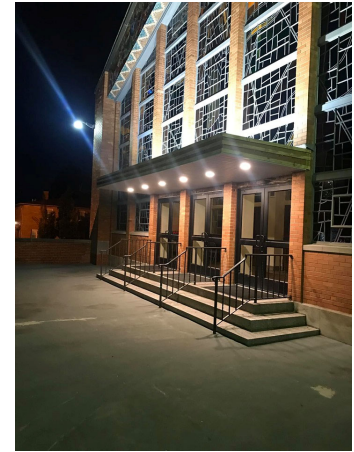

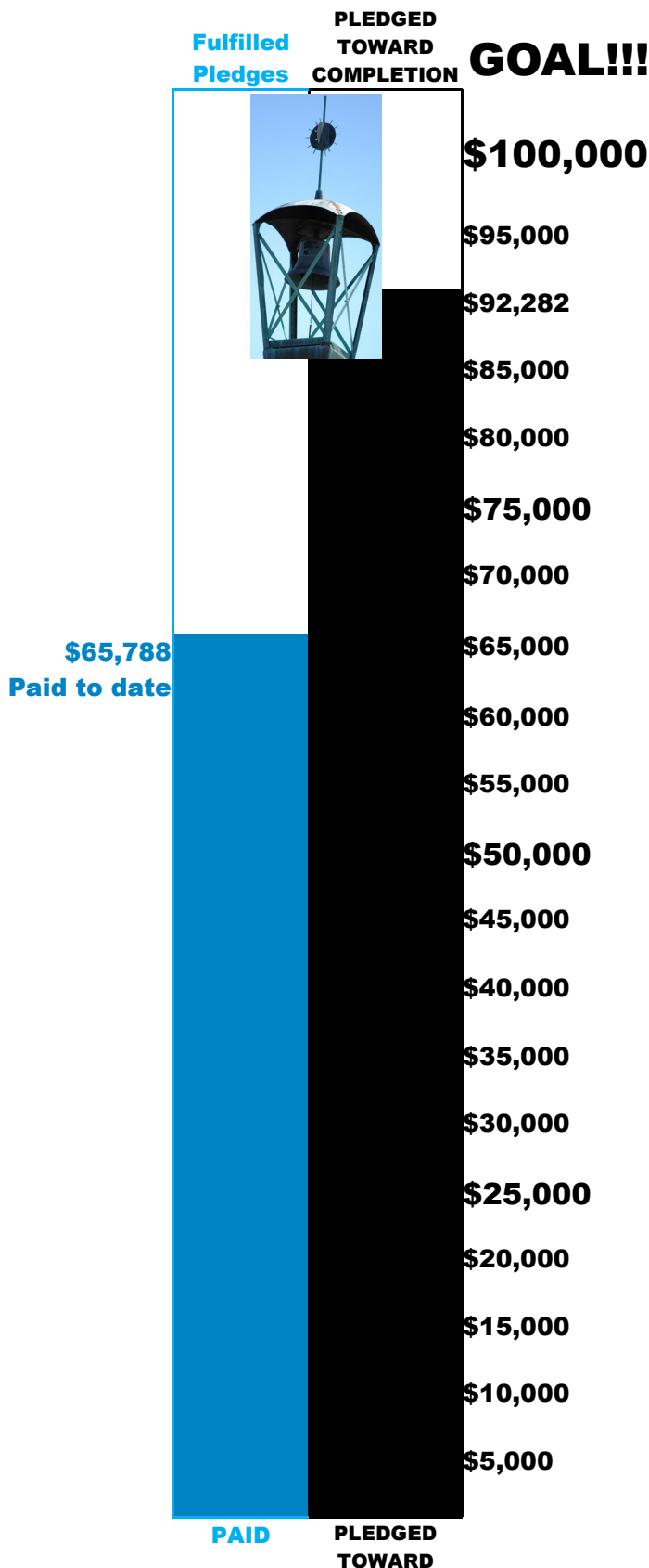
