Hey Kids! This is a cassette tape. It’s what we used to listen to music on before MP3s and CDs, and after LPs (also called records) and 8-tracks. I owned this album and played it so much I wore the tape inside the cassette out. It was this cassette that was the gateway to my almost 40-year love of Jimmy Buffett. In 1985, just 12 years or so into his career, this was his original greatest hits album. It’s title, *Songs You Know By Heart*, was spot on, as I have had the lyrics memorized for many years. His biggest song, Margaritaville, is known around the world, and it’s the familiar refrain that calls out to me this weekend. “...Some people claim that there’s a woman to blame, but I know, (bum, bum, bum, bum, bum) it’s my own ... fault.”

Every year on this First Sunday of Lent, we hear the Gospels about Jesus being tempted by the Devil while in the desert for 40 days and 40 nights. Jesus didn’t blame the Evil One or anyone else. I can tell you, brothers and sisters that the Devil is real. Evil is real. Nobody, neither the saints nor even Jesus himself, is immune. And neither are we. The struggle is real. We all deal with it. The truth is we will face temptation daily, but we don’t face it or the Evil One alone. I don’t have to give in. I can resist. I can choose to not sin. Don’t blame. Just turn to Jesus. Remember that this Lent! We have Jesus. Face the temptation, whatever it may be, with confidence.

Well, we’re here. Lent has begun. We’re approximately 5 days in thus far. We’ve made it to... the First Sunday of Lent. Congratulations! So... how is it going so far? Not sure how to start? Well, here’s just a few ways to help you get started, all at no cost to you:

1. Pray; fast; give alms. Remember the best Lent does all 3 practices.
2. Attend one, some, or all of the parish Lenten events found on our Lent calendar. There’s lots of options!

1. Read the daily Little Black Book reflection. This great little book has a short, 6 minutes or less reflection for each day of Lent. I've found it really helpful to focus my personal prayer during Lent. It's also available as an ebook.

2. After the Fish Fry, walk over to church and attend the Stations of the Cross, weekly on Lenten Fridays at 7 p.m.

Check out www.formed.org as well as **Word On Fire**, Bishop Barron's content that is available to you through the weekly parish email. You can find lots of additional opportunities to deepen your faith during Lent with these online resources that are free to you!

1. Attend an additional Mass during the week.

2. Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Saturdays at 4 p.m. Parish Communal Penance Service on March 28. Additional times to be announced.

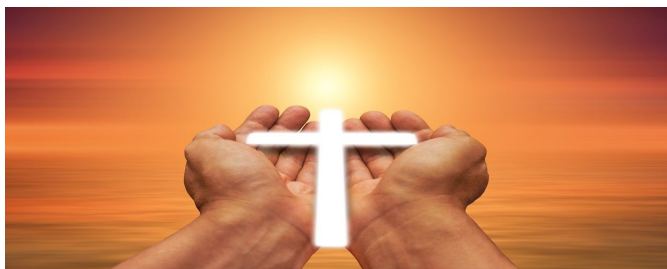
