# **ALL Volunteers, NEW and OLD**

As the school year begins, please take time to make sure that you are up to date and able to work with our children. All adults (age 18+) who want to volunteer in School or Parish activities, or ministries that include children, must be in full compliance with the Safe Environment Program of the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Compliance requires:

- Attend a Protecting God's Children live workshop and complete online updates every three years.
- Understand and sign the Archdiocese's Code of Ethical Conduct for Clergy, Employees, and Volunteers Working in Ministry.
- View two online training modules regarding abuse reporting and relevant topics from the Code of Ethical of Conduct.
- Complete a national criminal record check and agree to regular updates.

## Children's Liturgy of the Word CLOW Begins September 10, 2023

Liturgy of the Word for Children is a program that seeks to reach the hearts and minds of our littlest parishioners by offering an opportunity for children to learn the Gospel on their own level. We welcome children from grade K-2 at the 9:45 a.m. Mass from September through May. Any child in this age group may participate. No registration is necessary.

### What exactly do they do?

The children gather with their leader in the front of the altar after the Opening Prayer and are sent forth by the presider. In each session, an ageappropriate reflection on the Word is shared by the leader through stories, discussions, or pictures - whatever the leader finds most appropriate to convey the meaning of the scriptures. The children return to their families during the Offertory collection. We encourage you to allow your child to attend Children's Liturgy of the Word every Sunday. #### **CPOP TUITION ASSISTANCE FUND**

As the school year is about to begin, we would like to remind all parishioners of our Tuition Assistance Fund. We are extremely grateful to those who have donated throughout the years. Be assured that we have helped many families!

For the 2023-24 school year, 10 of our elementary students are receiving some level of tuition assistance from the parish. How do we award aid? The criteria for receiving aid are simple. First and foremost, tuition assistance scholarships are awarded to active and engaged parish families, as demonstrated by weekly Mass attendance. Participation in parish and school activities is a plus. Second, the family must demonstrate the need by submitting a completed application, obtained through the rectory. The application is supported by their most recent tax return. All applications are held in strict confidence. Recurring scholarship families are asked to reapply in the spring prior to the start of the new school year. However, families can apply anytime if their circumstances change during the year. If you are in need, please don't hesitate to contact Father Chris or Nancy Zoia. We would be happy to meet with you and walk you through the process.

How can I give? All parishioners have a monthly opportunity to donate to the Tuition Assistance Fund. Those who receive monthly envelopes have a green envelope in their packet for this fund; on-line givers have the fund available for donations.

Again, we thank all who make this possible through their generous donations. This program has been in place since 2008 and many children have been able to attend or continue their education at CPOP school due to this fund. Your continued donations to this fund will enable many more children to receive the outstanding Catholic education at CPOP School.
