This **Wednesday, November 1, 2023 is the Solemnity of All Saints**, a holy day of obligation, or HDOO, as the cool kids say. After all that hobnobbing with hobgoblins and the like the night before- don't forget to make time to attend Mass between cramming those Reese's Peanut Butter Cups and Milky Ways in your mouth. This **Thursday, November 2, 2023 is the Commemoration of All Souls**, when we pray for the souls of all of the faithful departed. We will have a special Mass of Remembrance that evening at 7 p.m. as we remember all of those who have had funerals at CPOP over the past 12 months. Members of those families have been personally invited to attend, but all are welcome as we pray for all of those who have gone before us. It is good and right for us to pray for those who have died. It is a corporal work of mercy to bury the dead, as well as a spiritual work of mercy to pray for the living and the dead.

We invite you to write the names of deceased family members and friends in our book of the dead. We will also have an altar of remembrance set up in church, and we invite you to bring pictures, funeral cards, and other mementos of deceased loved ones to place on the altar of remembrance. Both the book of the dead and the altar of remembrance will remain in church for the duration of the month of November.

Finally, I invite you to join me in participating in the **Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary**, starting on November 9 and ending on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas and the Unborn. **Total Consecration to Mary** includes daily prayers and brief reflections for every day. We will be using the book **33 Days to Morning Glory, A Do-It-Yourself Retreat in Preparation for Marian Consecration** by Fr. Michael E. Gaitley. The beauty is you can do this all on your own. I have some copies in booklet form, or you can order it online. If interested, please see me or email me at cdunlap@cpopschool.com. Why should you do this? In the author's words, "We consecrate ourselves in order to be more devoted to the Lord and His Blessed Mother. It helps us grow in holiness and increase our faith, hope, and love. It is a prayerful and focused method of drawing closer to Jesus than ever before."
