





UPCOMING MEMORIAL

St. Ignatius Loyola

This week we celebrate a spiritual master! Not only is St. Ignatius Loyola the founder of the Jesuits, but the legacy of his life of prayer -- now called Ignatian spirituality -- inspired believers the world over. Injured as a young soldier, Ignatius spent his time in recovery reading the lives of the saints. They inspired his soul to holy heroism, changing his life forever. Ignatius gathered a group of friends who also desired to be "contemplatives in action," finding God in all circumstances. This became the Jesuits -- a great missionary and teaching order. Ignatius himself was constantly attuned to his own inner promptings. This self-knowledge -- open to the movements of the Holy Spirit -- led him to be an incredibly astute spiritual director. For Ignatius, recognizing God as the first principles of one's life determined everything. How has God changed you?



PRÓXIMO MONUMENTO

San Ignacio de Loyola

¡Esta semana celebramos a un maestro espiritual! San Ignacio de Loyola no solo es el fundador de los jesuitas, sino que el legado de su vida de oración, ahora llamada espiritualidad ignaciana, inspiró a creyentes de todo el mundo. Herido cuando era un joven soldado, Ignacio pasó su tiempo en recuperación leyendo las vidas de los santos. Inspiraron su alma al santo heroísmo, cambiando su vida para siempre. Ignacio reunió a un grupo de amigos que también deseaban ser "contemplativos en la acción", encontrando a Dios en todas las circunstancias. Esto se convirtió en los jesuitas, una gran orden misionera y docente. El mismo Ignacio estaba constantemente en sintonía con sus propios impulsos internos. Este autoconocimiento, abierto a los movimientos del Espíritu Santo, lo llevó a ser un director espiritual increíblemente astuto. Para Ignacio, reconocer a Dios como los primeros principios de la propia vida determinaba todo. ¿Cómo te ha cambiado Dios?



St. Alphonsus Liguori

Saint Alphonsus was born into a well-respected family in 1696, in Marianella, in the Kingdom of Naples. He received an exceptional education through private tutors and was conferred degrees in civil and canon law at 16. He practiced law for 8 years before he turned to the Church. He was ordained a priest in 1726. Saint Alphonsus traveled for 26 years in Kingdom of Naples preaching. His style of ministry was called "mission among the people," he and a group of priests or lay brothers would go to rural areas, staying for a time to teach, preach, and pray with the people there. In 1762 Saint Alphonsus was made a bishop by Pope Clement XIII, however, he was eventually allowed to resign his post because of his ill health. He was paralyzed for a time from rheumatic fever in 1775, and had rheumatism so severe it was deforming, bending his head so far forward that his chin rested on his chest. He died peacefully at the age of 90 in 1787. He was canonized in 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI, and in 1871 he was named a doctor of the church by Pope Pius IX. In 1950 he was declared patron of moral theologians by Pope Pius XII.



PRÓXIMO MONUMENTO

San Alfonso de Ligorio

San Alfonso nació en una familia muy respetada en 1696, en Marianella, en el Reino de Nápoles. Recibió una educación excepcional a través de tutores privados y se le confirieron títulos en derecho civil y canónico a los 16 años. Ejerció la abogacía durante 8 años antes de volverse a la Iglesia. Fue ordenado sacerdote en 1726. San Alfonso viajó durante 26 años por el Reino de Nápoles predicando. Su estilo de ministerio se llamaba "misión entre la gente", él y un grupo de sacerdotes o hermanos laicos iban a las zonas rurales y se quedaban por un tiempo para enseñar, predicar y orar con la gente allí. En 1762 San Alfonso fue nombrado obispo por el Papa Clemente XIII, sin embargo, finalmente se le permitió renunciar a su cargo debido a su mala salud. Estuvo paralizado por un tiempo a causa de la fiebre reumática en 1775 y tenía un reumatismo tan severo que lo deformaba, inclinando la cabeza tanto hacia adelante que la barbilla descansaba sobre el pecho. Murió en paz a la edad de 90 años en 1787. Fue canonizado en 1839 por el Papa Gregorio XVI, y en 1871 fue nombrado doctor de la iglesia por el Papa Pío IX. En 1950 fue declarado patrono de los teólogos morales por el Papa Pío XII.


