Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary



This Sunday's three readings remind us that we are at the end of the liturgical year. The first narrates the beauty of a hardworking and industrious woman, who with her hands does beautiful work and helps those who are in misfortune.

Paul makes a personal invitation to live confident in the definitive encounter with the Lord. "You are all children of the light and children of the day: we are not of the night nor of the darkness" (Thessalonians 5:3). The Gospel emphasizes the talents that God has given us, because we will give an account to God about them. What gifts have I received from God? How do I make them produce? There is a gift from God for everyone and it is universal, it is called love.

Lord, help me grow the gifts you have given me. May I know how to share what I am and what I have, may I not be selfish or sterile in my purposes. Also, help me help my family and friends who have buried their talents for fear of losing and making mistakes. "We have all received from God a heritage as human beings, a human wealth, of whatever kind. And as disciples of Christ, we have also received the faith, the Gospel, the Holy Spirit, the sacraments, and so many other things. These gifts must be used to do good, good in this life, as a service to God and to our brothers and sisters" (Pope Francis 11-15-2020). Remember this phrase: "At the evening of life, we will be examined in love"

El Evangelio hace hincapié en los talentos que Dios nos ha regalado, pues sobre ellos daremos cuenta a Dios. ¿Qué regalos he recibido de Dios? ¿Cómo los hago producir? Existe un regalo de Dios para todos y es universal, se llama amor.

Señor, ayúdame a hacer crecer los regalos que me has dado. Que sepa compartir lo que soy y lo que tengo, que no sea egoísta, ni estéril en mis propósitos. También, ayúdame a ayudar a mi familia y amigos que han enterrado sus talentos por miedo a perder y equivocarse. "Todos hemos recibido de Dios un patrimonio como seres humanos, una riqueza humana, del tipo que sea. Y como discípulos de Cristo, también hemos recibido la fe, el Evangelio, el Espíritu Santo, los sacramentos, y tantas otras cosas. Estos dones hay que emplearlos para hacer el bien, el bien en esta vida, como servicio a Dios y a los hermanos" (Papa Francisco 11-15-2020). The Knights of Columbus will be serving up a hot pancake breakfast in the hall after this Sunday's morning Masses.


