

Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children



On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States. Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion.

On June 24, 2022, the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision overturned Roe v. Wade. While God in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, right now state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to preborn children.

In our state of California, Proposition 1 just passed. Our state's constitution will now have an amendment stating that there is a right to abortion. This means unlimited abortions, at any stage of pregnancy, fully funded by tax payer dollars.

Prayer and advocacy is very needed, and so we continue remembering this day as a day of loss of countless lives and we unite in prayer for the legal protection of preborn children in every single state of our nation and the world.

El 22 de enero de 1973, la Corte Suprema legalizó el aborto en todo Estados Unidos. Desde entonces, millones de niños han perdido la vida y millones de mujeres y familias han resultado heridas por el aborto. El 24 de junio de 2022, la decisión de la Organización de Salud de la Mujer Dobbs v. Jackson anuló Roe v. Wade. Dios, en su misericordia, puso fin al régimen nacional de casi cincuenta años de aborto, en este momento las leyes estatales y federales, en muchos casos, siguen siendo hostiles a los niños no nacidos. En nuestro estado de California, acaba de aprobarse la Proposición 1. La constitución de nuestro estado ahora tendrá una enmienda que establece que existe el derecho al aborto. Esto significa abortos ilimitados, en cualquier etapa del embarazo, financiados íntegramente con el dinero de los contribuyentes. La oración y la defensa son muy necesarias, por eso continuamos recordando este día como un día de pérdida de innumerables vidas y nos unimos en oración por la protección legal de los niños no nacidos en cada estado de nuestra nación y del mundo.
