

#### SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

## **Baptism**

Baptism is the sacrament of new life. It is the entrance gate and foundation of the whole Christian existence. It is a sign of faith and conversion, of turning one's life towards Jesus Christ. Baptism brings the task of a lifelong growth and maturation in the faith, through Baptism we are received into the Church. Parents seeking Baptism for their child must apply at our Parish Office at least 3 months in advance.

#### Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the Sick is the sacrament that is received by those who are ill or suffering. By the sacred anointing and the prayer of the priest, the whole Church commends those who are sick to Christ. The sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gifts of strength, faith, peace, and courage, and his or her suffering is united with the suffering of Christ for the building up of the Church (Catechism of the Catholic Church [CCC], nos. 1520-23). If you would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please call our Pastoral Care Coordinator at (760) 564 - 1255.

#### <u>Matrimony</u>

The Parish recognizes the importance of the marriage decision and seeks to assist each couple with a period of preparation in which they will grow in an ever deepening love for each other. Couples seeking marriage must apply at our Parish Office at least 9 months in advance to allow this preparation to be completed adequately.

# **Holy Orders**

By virtue of our Baptism, all Christians are part of a common priesthood of believers. We are all called to participate in Christ's mission.

Through the Sacrament of Holy Orders, bishops and priests are given a special role in carrying out this mission. They exercise a ministerial priesthood. Deacons also receive a special grace through ordination and are called to assist the ministry of bishops and priests



#### ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT

#### ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI CATHOLIC CHURCH

FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2025



Dear Parishioners,

Each fall, we have the opportunity of providing the Parish with financial reports for the previous fiscal year. To that end, please see a synopsis of our operations, whose success is wholly dependent on your financial stewardship.

The revenue for this past fiscal year was at its highest level over the past ten years. This is a wonderful positive trend as we begin construction of "Our Parish Our Future – A church that builds community, with love and open arms to everyone" discussed later in this report.

The Parish, once again, generated an operating profit. This is a very positive sign, as we begin to add needed staff delayed due to COVID and implement delayed maintenance expenses. Continued growth of revenue will be necessary to ensure future positive results.


With that background, for the year ended June 30, 2025, the Parish generated revenue of \$2,502,000, which is \$296,000 higher than the prior year. Much of this positive variance is due to the generosity of the many parishioners who helped fund our beautiful new Sanctuary.

Parish expenses for the year were \$2,194,000, which is \$309,000 higher than last year. Most of the negative expense variances are attributable to needed staff additions, and maintenance and repairs needed to keep our facilities, which are over 35 years old, in good order. Some of the larger necessary expenses during 2024-2025 included:

- ·New security system \$112,000
- ·Sand Flower Rectory work \$67,000.
- New Sanctuary (Tabernacle, Gospel Book Stand, Candelabras, Candle Stands, Flower Stands) Marble & Tile-\$200,800
- ·Residential air conditioning repairs and replacements \$11,200
- ·Church air conditioning repairs and replacements -\$14,000
- ·Phone system upgrade \$10,800.

These projects combined to generate a cash operating gain of \$308,000. After giving effect to depreciation for the year of \$287,000, the Parish had a net income of \$21,000.

Our Parish's sources of revenue and major expense categories include:



In summary, your continued faithful stewardship has enabled us to celebrate the sacraments, support our parish ministries, maintain our facilities, and assist those in need. Together, we continue to live out the Gospel and build up the Body of Christ in our community.

As we close fiscal year 2024-2025 operationally, we now turn to 2025-2026.

As you have hopefully seen, the light at the end of our tunnel shines brightly and the construction of "Our Parish, Our Future – A church that builds community, with love and open arms to everyone" has begun.

As a reminder, the construction of the new Parish Hall and Administration building is separately funded from our ongoing operating costs and will increase our future operational expenses when the new buildings are complete.

A separate letter detailing the status of our capital campaign and what we need to fund 100% of the project, will be included in the bulletin soon.

We pray that all those who have not donated will join those that have, recognizing your financial stewardship obligation to support the capital needs of your Parish, to the extent you are able, just as you support our ongoing operational needs.

We also pray that those who have already fulfilled their prior pledge will find it in their hearts to renew that pledge.

My dear fellow Parishioners, I thank you very much for your continued support and faithfulness to our Lord, Jesus Christ and our parish. May God bless all of you, strengthen those who are ill, comfort those that are grief stricken and may our Blessed Mother Mary, Mother of Perpetual Help, pray for all of us.
