This weekend at all the Masses we recognize and thank all those who give generously of their time to the parish as a volunteer. One of the striking qualities of Christ the King Parish is the number of parishioners who are involved in the various aspects of parish life from the Sacred Liturgy, to the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, to the school, to the grounds, etc. On behalf of the entire parish community I offer my sincere thanks for all that you do.

I also wanted to alert parishioners to the spiritual opportunities coming up for Advent. We are sponsoring a "retreat" on Tuesday evenings in Advent with Confession at 5 p.m., Mass at 6 p.m. and an Advent Talk at 6:45 p.m. The Sacrament of Confession should be a regular part of our spiritual life, and especially in the penitential seasons of Advent and Lent. For our Advent retreat we have an impressive lineup of Ryan Mainard, Linda Mainard, Dina Marie Hale and Dr. Elaine Park. Please see the Advent flyer for more information about our speakers, expanded times for Confession, the Advent Penance Service here and at other parishes in the Vicariate, and our celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

We are also going to have a day of Adoration on the Feast of St. Nicholas, December 6th. This opportunity is not on the flyer but has been scheduled. There will be the normal weekday Mass at 8 a.m., followed by Exposition and Adoration all day until Benediction at 5:45 p.m. You have heard me speak often about being a Eucharistic Parish, a parish focused on Jesus and His Real Presence the Eucharist. Advent is a time of waiting and spiritual preparation for Christmas. I cannot think of a better way to prepare than to spend some time in Adoration of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. Look for signups in the back of church. We'll want to have at least two adorers for each hour.
