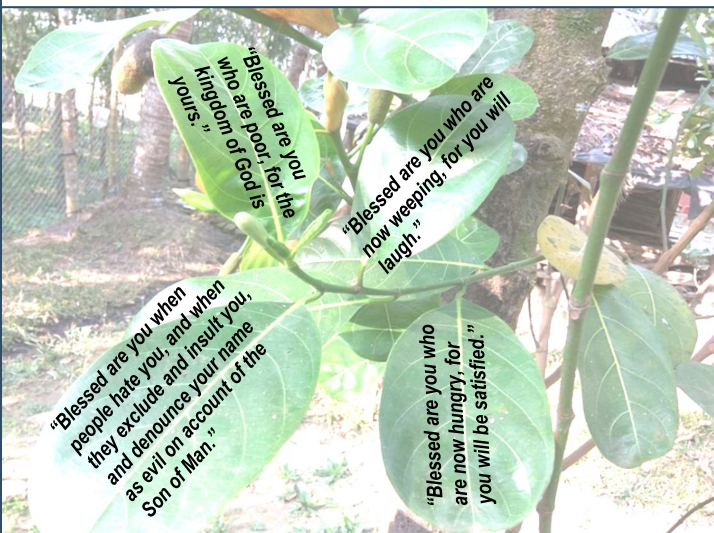

Centering Prayer meets at CTK the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month at 1:00 p.m., in Room B and is a method of meditation that places an emphasis on interior silence. *Some of the guidelines for Centering Prayer:* Choose a sacred word as the symbol of your consent to God's presence and action within. At the end of the prayer period (usually 20 minutes), remain in silence with eyes closed for a few minutes. Conclude with "The Glory Be," "The Hail Mary" or "The Our Father."
