One of the main points of the book is cultivating "holy moments" in the day. The homepage on our updated website has some concrete suggestions in how to do that.

Also on our updated website you can find that we are "committed to being a Eucharistic parish - a community that finds its source and center in Jesus Christ, truly present among us in the Blessed Sacrament. He unites us. He animates and directs all of our efforts at evangelization, education and serving those in need."

Our parish has a long tradition of serving those in need. I think of the excellent work being done by those involved in St. Vincent de Paul and our dedicated group who serves at St. Andre's Cafe in downtown Portland, as well as other groups in the parish who in some way serve those in need. This year we have expanded our outreach in a new direction with the help of Anne Hill and the support of the Pastoral Council. Our parish has become a participating church in the Compassion Connect Clinic (compassionconnect.com). This is an effort of several area churches in Clackamas County to provide, on a quarterly basis, basic health care (medical, dental, vision), as well as social services, prayer and food for those who are low income, experiencing homelessness, undocumented and refugees. I am supportive of this initiative as it calls us to take our Christian charity beyond our parish to our local community and fosters our relationship with other churches in the area. We are looking for volunteers to help with the next three clinics on March 1, June 15 and September 21. No particular expertise in required to volunteer, just a heart for service.
