

I would like to thank our hard-working Maintenance and Safety Committee for successfully completing two major projects these past couple of months: the new sound system and the new lighting system in our church. Our new Principal, Sarah Brentano, has done some outstanding work her first year and we are committed to making Christ the King parish school the best Catholic grade school in Oregon.

We have now concluded the Christmas season. Thank you to all those who helped make the church and our celebrations beautiful, as well as those who helped our outreach to those in need during this time.
