Brothers and Sisters,

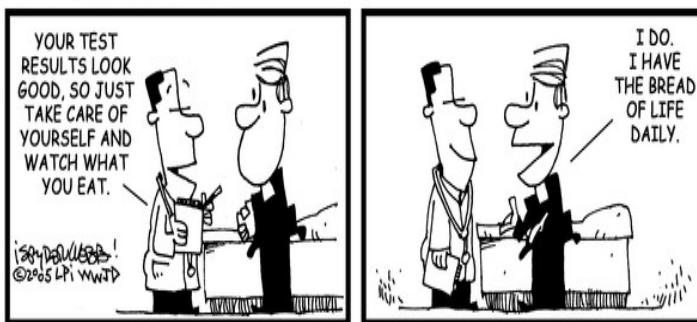

Matthew 4:12-23

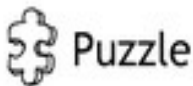

Dear God, thank you that with Jesus I don't need to be afraid.

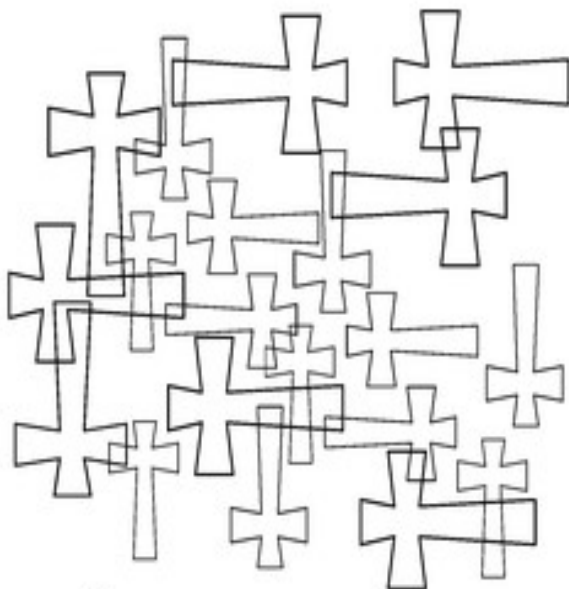
