LIFE IS SACRED

It's a crazy-busy life in the 21st Century and there never seems to be enough time for any of us, but there are some issues so great, so compelling, they cry out for our attention and action.

Did you know our parish sponsors an active pro-life group? The unspeakable actions of our culture demand it. January 22, 2020 was the 47th anniversary of the legalization of taking the lives of the innocent unborn. There are many issues of justice addressed in the prolife movement and all are important, but one stands out for its sheer scope in the destruction and detestation of life, marriage, families, individuals, and peace in our nation and our world. There can be no true peace among us until there is peace in the womb, where every child is protected and loved because God has so ordained it.

As of 10:30 am PST on this past January 22, over 1.5 Billion unborn Children have been erased from the planet since 1973. In the same time frame in the US, Americans have aborted over 61.6 Million of our Children, growing and developing in their Mothers' wombs. Just since January 1st, 2020, 50,650 Unborn Innocents have lost their lives in this country. And talk about injustice, since 1973 in the US, 18,503,770 Unborn Children of Color never got to see the light of day, a disproportionate tragedy for our nation.

At Christ the King parish, our prolife committee, Life is Sacred, gathers to pray, both in petition and reparation, for the sins of our nation and the world. We strive to promote the Sanctity of all Human Life, born and unborn, from conception to natural death, regardless of circumstance or condition. Our special charism is to help our parish be a place of peace, where every person is loved and embraced as a Child of God, chosen and created by Him.

We meet on the 3rd Monday of each month, 6-7 pm, in Room C at the parish olice building and we invite you to join us! Now is the time. One hour, once a month, is very much worth our time as a contribution to the Sanctity of Human Life. This concerns the single most compelling issue of our time, ending new lives God has created, and if we want to leave a better world for our children and grandchildren, we have to be engaged in protecting human life now.

As St. Theresé of Lisieux wrote, "We have only this short life to show the Good God how

much we love Him." We will have all eternity to rest, so you are invited to come to Life is Sacred. All are invited- Parents, grandparents, teens, children, infants, because Life is, indeed, Sacred at Christ the King!
