

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Brothers and Sisters,

The beautiful season of **Lent** is upon us! This liturgical season helps us prepare and train for the most important day of the year: Easter, the day of the Resurrection, through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Please post the **Lenten flyer** on the fridge at home as a reminder of all the opportunities for spiritual growth and training here in the parish, and take advantage of the offerings: the Parish Mission, Confession, Adoration, Stations of the Cross, Bible Study, etc.

In a special way, we direct our prayers to our **cate-chumens and candidates** who will be receiving the Sacraments at the Easter Vigil and who have entered the period of immediate preparation. This is a time when the evil one can try to stir up doubts and discouragement. Our prayers and fasting can help strengthen them in this final period. Please visit the poster in the back of church to familiarize yourself with those who are coming into the Church and to write one of them a note of encouragement.

Lent also can be a time when people may be considering a return to the Church or considering becoming a Catholic. I want to highlight our Welcome Ta**ble** in the Parish Center. This is a place where those who are newcomers or just visiting can find out information about the Catholic Faith, our parish, the opportunities to get involved and how to register. If we see someone at Mass who is new, please introduce yourself and invite that person to the Welcome Table after Mass. If you see anyone hanging about the Welcome Table, please introduce yourself and invite that person to your table for a visit. Evangelization begins with a smile and a warm welcome. Mother Teresa, whose Sisters were often sent into places where they didn't know the language or customs, would tell her Sisters: remember, the first proclamation of the Gospel is with your smile.

Let us engage in the spiritual exercises of Lent, do spiritual battle in furthering the Kingdom of God in ourselves and around us, and encourage one another in our Lenten observance. We are in this together and together, with the Lord's grace, be ready to enter with Him into His passion, death and resurrection - His Paschal Mystery.

The Seven Churches Visitation: A Holy Thursday Tradition

Holy Thursday marks the end of Lent and the beginning of the Holy Triduum. We celebrate this feast by remembering the Passover Meal where Jesus shared the bread and wine with the Apostles and gave us the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.

The Seven Churches Visitation is a customary tradition practiced by many Catholics all over the world. At the end of Holy Thursday Mass the Eucharist is placed in an altar away from the sanctuary where the faithful will proceed to spend time in prayer and adoration. The faithful will then visit seven churches during the night for prayer and Adoration to correspond with the seven stations made by Jesus between the Last Supper and His Crucifixion.

This is a powerful way to prepare Easter by visiting parishes and seeking Christ to spend time with Him in to the night. We will publish churches in our area that will remain open until Midnight and any information necessary for you to take part in this rich tradition.


