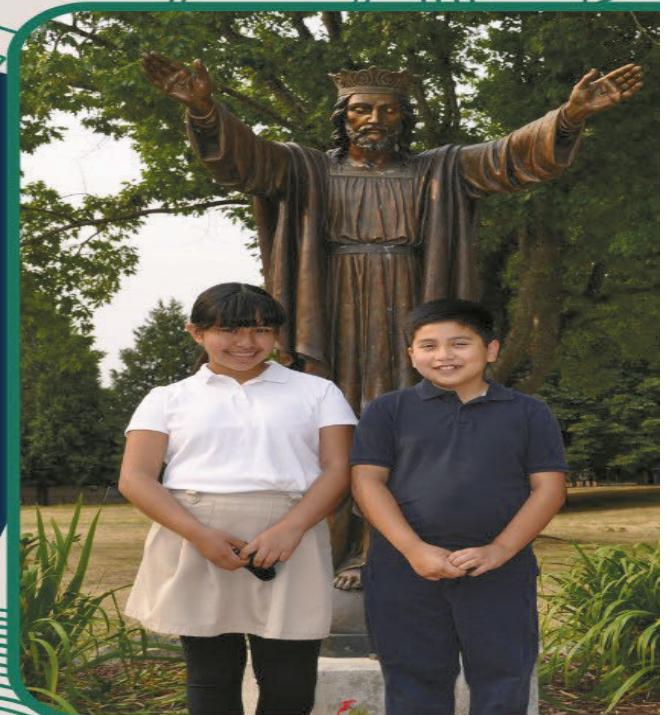

PROGRAM GOALS

The PreK program at Christ the King Parish School encourages children to create their own learning environment in which they learn to be independent, experiment, problem solve, be creative, use their imagination, act Christ like and, most importantly, to be safe, have fun and make new friends. Our goal is to provide a welcoming and loving environment in which young children will thrive and grow. This is a time where your child will begin new relationships and continue to build on them throughout their Christ the King school career.

ACTIVITIES

We offer both teacher-directed and child-directed activities with a balance of inside and outside play, active and quiet times and hands-on learning. The program includes art, music, PE, science, pre-math, pre-reading, pre-language skills, social and emotional teachings, self-regulation skills and spiritual growth. Activities align with the School Wide Learning Expectations, the Archdiocesan Curriculum Guidelines and preparation for Kindergarten.

CLASS SIZE/ STAFF

The PreK class is a 1:10 ratio with 1 Teacher.

ENROLLMENT

PreK students will need to be 4 years-old by September 1st to be enrolled.

SCHOOL YEAR

PreK classes are in session from September through middle of June, following the Christ the King Parish School academic calendar.

PREK FAQs

What does literacy and math time look like?

Each block has a portion of all group instruction and activities. In literacy, children are learning letter and letter sounds, phonological awareness, rhyming words, story comprehension, vocabulary, and handwriting. In math, children are learning shapes, counting, number sense and recognition, sorting, patterning, measurement, and joining-stories. Children learn through teacher-directed instruction and activities, hands-on activities, songs, stories, and child-led center time.

How long is rest time?

Students have a rest time after lunch. Rest time is usually 1 hour. Children bring a small bag with a blanket and animal or pillow. Children who don't rest are offered a variety of quiet activities.

Break, Snack, Lunch

Students need to bring snacks from home and a water bottle. NO NUT snacks. For lunch, your child can bring a lunch from home (no nuts) or pre-order lunch through the school's lunch program. Children are provided milk.

When do children attend Mass?

PreK students attend Mass in the spring. Mass is on Thursday mornings at 8:30am.

What is your discipline policy?

We are solution focused. When a problem arises we will try to help the child/children solve it by talking about it with those involved and helping them find a better way to resolve their problem. If a problem continues, the teacher will let the parents know so that we can problem solve together.

How much outdoor time do children get?

PreK has a morning recess for 20 minutes and another 20 minute recess before lunch. We have a beautiful courtyard behind our classroom we spend time in as well.

With higher Kindergarten standards many children struggle with the transition from preschool to kindergarten. Our PreK program offers a balance of teacher and child directed activities which allows children to become familiar with school in a developmentally appropriate way. Our students are academically prepared and through self-regulation skills they are able to manage the social and emotional challenges that may arise in kindergarten.
