



# CHRIST THE KING ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT For the year ending June 30, 2022

#### Dear Parishioners,

The accompanying annual report shows the financial performance of Christ the King Parish for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, as well as our annual budget for July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Our goal is that this report helps you understand how your contributions to the Parish are used and accounted for, and all the good that they accomplish. I am so grateful for your continued generosity to accomplish the mission the Lord has given us.

General offertory income was under the budgeted amount for the fiscal year by approximately 6.5%. Special collections, bequests, and other revenue sources helped with the shortfall, bumping total revenue to just over the budgeted offertory amount for the year.

Expenses were well managed during the year, allowing for a total surplus of \$47,429 for the fiscal year (budgeted surplus was \$97,937).

Here are some of the highlights from the parish this past fiscal year:

- Successfully fundraised for 3 new ultrasound machines (\$30,000) for First Image in the Portland metro area
- Performance of VIANNEY! by St. Luke Production
- Advent Retreat: Healing the Whole Person
- Advent Music Concert
- Tuesday Talk with Archbishop Sample on Living in a New Apostolic Age
- Lenten Mission with Sr. Miriam Heidland, SOLT
- Bishop Barron Series on the Mass Fridays during Lent
- Tenebrae Service during Holy Week
- Performance of TOLTON: from Slave to Priest by St. Luke Production
- NET retreat for our parish and school youth, Steubenville NW trip, Ignite Your Torch and Quo Vadis Days for our high school youth
- Everybody's Vacation Bible School
- Marian Consecration (Solemnity of the Assumption)
- Inauguration of Healing Holy Hours
- New 3-year Pastoral Vision from the Pastoral Council

In this time period, 51 people joined the parish. We celebrated 14 baptisms, 29 First Confessions/First Holy Communion, 4 Confirmations, 3 Weddings, 22 Funerals.

As you have probably noticed, this last fiscal year was an extremely busy one in the Parish. The following major projects and improvements were completed during 2021-22:

- Remodel/updating of the parish office (paint, carpet, light fixtures, kitchen, front entrance)
- New organ for the church
- Rekeyed locks of all the buildings on campus
- Fencing of the middle school outdoor area
- Added concrete sidewalk around outside of middle school
- Continued development of Audiovisual/IT systems in the parish center and church
- Integration of rectory with rest of parish fiber IT system
- Integration of parish office entrance with campus wide PDK security system
- Installed gates and fencing at property entrances to increase security

Upcoming needs for the 22-23 fiscal year include:

- New signage at the property entrances
- New heating and cooling system for school to move off energy inefficient boiler
- New flooring/carpet for church interior
- Paint exterior of school and parish office to match parish center and church

As reflected in the 22-23 budget, we are hopeful that our offertory contributions will get to the \$780k level so that we can continue to maintain and update our facilities and continue on with our mission. We ask that you continue your wonderful support of our Parish and to also prayerfully consider increasing (or starting) your offertory contributions. We would strongly encourage parishioners to sign up for online giving as it is the safest way to contribute.

We have a number of new parishioners who have joined our family this past year. If you haven't yet registered and begun regular giving, please do so online or let the office know and we'll get you set up!
