


IN OUR PRAYERS

2022-2023 WESTON REPORT



We have a wonderful opportunity each year to take advantage of matching funds from the Weston Foundation to support our school. DEACON'S MESSAGE

What is the difference between a **diocesan** and a **religious** priest? (Source: USCCB and Catholic Answers)

A <u>diocesan priest</u> is a priest ordained for a particular (arch)diocese and normally serves in a parish, but can be engaged in other ministries as well. Msgr. Cihak and myself are *diocesan* clergy. Unlike the religious orders who take vows, we make two promises: *celibacy* and *obedience to our* (arch)bishop and his successors. While we do not make a vow of poverty, the expectation is that we lead a life of simplicity.

We wear the black clerical attire, wear what is called a *Roman Collar*, and normally do not live in a community, though Archbishop Sample is a great advocate for fraternity among the seminarians and clergy.

A **religious priest** refers to a specific form of life these priests live, not that they are more religious than the diocesan! All men and women who make public vows in a religious order are called *religious*. Typically they make vows of *poverty*, *celibate chastity*, and *obedience*. Their lives are oriented in a special way to the virtue of religion. Normally, they live and pray in community, and many wear a *religious habit* (Jesuits and Holy Cross, for example, do not). They usually have a specialized form of ministry. The diversity of orders shows the beauty of the expressions of the faith in the Church!

Examples of Religious Orders: Benedictines, Jesuits, Dominicans, Carmelites, Franciscans.

My Brothers and Sisters,

I'd like to provide an update on "A Catholic Response to Gender Identity Theory", available at archdpdx.org/gender. Many have expressed gratitude for the clarity this document provides on Church teachings. We are proud of this document and pleased with all the feedback we've received from Catholics throughout the Archdiocese. We are grateful to God for teaching us, through His Church, the truth about the human person. Although it addresses Catholic schools, I encourage everyone to read the document and to prayerfully reflect on it.

I want to address some inaccurate media reports that have led to some confusion:

- Recent changes at the Department of Catholic Schools are not in any way tied to the Gender Identity Theory document or its related controversy.
- There are no plans to close any school. Our Catholic schools are an essential part of our mission of evangelization. The importance of the mission and our dedication to our families is unchanging.
- 3. No student has been excluded from any Catholic school or parish. Our doors are open to everyone and always will be. As Catholics, we joyfully abide by the Church's teachings and moral principles when we are forming the consciences of our children. This includes those moral principles articulated in the Gender Identity Theory document.

God gives us free will to embrace or reject Catholic teaching, but as your Archbishop, I implore you to examine your conscience and turn to the truth. Please know that you are loved by God, and by me. May the Spirit of God fill you with His love, His joy, and His hope.

We are excited to answer the call of Archbishop Sample and offer a Catholic Liberal Education to our students, so they will know and value what is true and good and beautiful. This three-year philosophy shift at CTK will begin next year (23-24) with a focus on History and Language, with teachers using story and literature in a more prominent and intentional way.
