Christmas Food Boxes are <u>BACK</u>






This year, in lieu of gift cards, our conference will be delivering Christmas food boxes to food pantry clients!

Preview food list for St. Vincent de Paul Christmas Food Box '23



Here's a preview of suggested foods to fill a Christmas food box. If you're a bargain shopper, you can start collecting these items as you see them on sale! We'll have the actual box available the weekend before Thanksgiving, so keep you at home until the first weekend of Advent - Dec. 2nd & 3rd.



PLEASE AVOID SUPER-SIZED PRODUCTS & GLASS CONTAINERS To keep all boxes similar, these first 15 items are essential

Here's our suggested list of needed items to fill a "Christmas Box"

- 1) Pancake Mix (1 box) & Pancake Syrup (1 bottle)
- 2) Ground Coffee (10-12 oz), Tea & Hot Cocoa Mix (choose 1-2 items)
- 3) Peanut Butter (10 oz) and Jam or Jelly (10 oz)
- 4) Canned Meats tuna, chicken, turkey, Spam or similar (4-6 cans)
- 5) Boxed Cold Cereal (1 box) and (1 box) Hot Cereal
- 6) Box of Dinner Helper (Suggestion: Pasta Roni, Rice A Roni, or similar)
- 7) Package dry pasta, spaghetti or similar (1 12-16 oz package)
- 8) Canned Pasta Sauce or Spaghetti Sauce (1-2 cans)
- 9) Canned Fruit, Peaches, Pears or similar (3-4 cans)
- 10) Canned Vegetables, Green Beans, Corn or similar (4-6 cans)
- 11) Canned Soups, Stew and Chili or similar (4-6 cans)
- 12) Dry packaged mashed potatoes (1 box)
- 13) Packaged gravy mix (2 packages)
- 14) Cake Mix w/frosting, Brownie Mix or similar dessert (1 box)
- 15) Treats mixed nuts and/or candy, cookies (you decide)



Other items that can be added:

 Pork and Beans, Olives, Top Ramen, Mac and Cheese, any canned or dry packaged items you think may be appropriate to fill your box. At time of delivery, we will supply a frozen ham, etc.



Please keep your groceries until we hand out the actual box. The earliest we can receive your filled box is the first weekend of Advent.
