
Day 5 - Siena Wednesday - May 24, 2023



Questions for Personal Reflection/Journaling

When you reach the daily destination of the pilgrimage, consider the following questions that you can pray with or journal your thoughts:

- 1. What stood out to you at each holy site?
- 2. What kinds of sacrifices have you made on this pilgrimage?
- 3. Are there habits or other areas of your life that you can offer to the Lord as you make this pilgrimage?
- 4. Who inspires you in your faith life?
- 5. Who introduced you to Christ, the Church, and/or your Catholic faith? Think of these people as your spiritual companion on the journey today.
- 6. Where is God calling you to change?
- 7. What are your God given gifts/talents that you can share on this pilgrimage and in everyday life as you return home?




As you journey, consider the following and take a moment to look at and notice these things. We can quickly pass by them, but on pilgrimage, we are challenged to stop and appreciate the holy moments on the journey. With each of these, take time to pray to God and express gratitude. Also consider what emotions or thoughts you experience when you notice these things:

- 1. How did you feel on your journey from your home to the destination?
- 2. Are you excited, tired, uncertain, prayerful, indifferent, or anxious?
- 3. Was your heart drawn to a particular work of art, icon, or statue?
- 4. What is the longing in your heart you wish to bring to the Lord?
- 5. Be still in silence and consider the five senses as you enter each holy space. Describe in detail how it spoke to you.

It was at the same time Pope Francis announced that he would be attending The World Meeting of Families in Philadelphia. I really wanted to go but did not want to go alone. With one advertisement and fifty-six pilgrims registered, we traveled from Indiana to Philadelphia on a private motorcoach to attend the Papal Mass on Benjamin Franklin Parkway. The rest is history.
