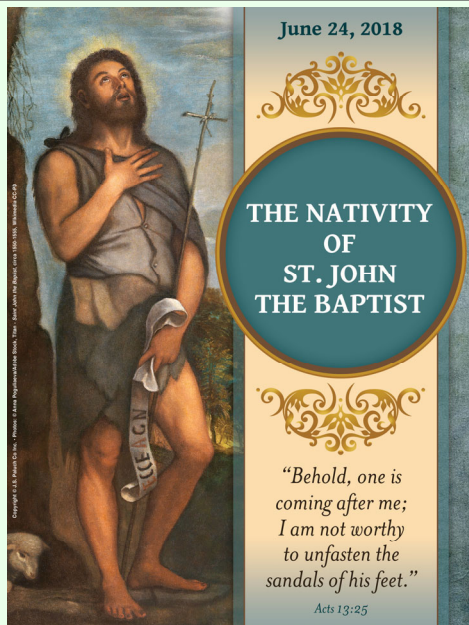

IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Dear Parishioners,

On behalf of the St. Rose of Lima Parish Finance Council, Pastoral Council and Building Committee, I am pleased to share with you that Bishop Soto has approved the following three parish projects:

- To remodel and expand the home adjacent to the church as the parish rectory = \$360,000
- For the purchase and installation of new audio/ visual systems for both the Church and Hall = \$220,000
- To remove the popcorn ceiling and repaint the interior surfaces of the Church = \$175,000

Total Approved Expenditure Granted
From Parish Savings = \$755,000

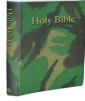

JOHN THE BAPTIST

Since June 24 falls on a Sunday this year, the Church has the opportunity for a more intense celebration of the birth of John the Baptist, who is often described as the last of the Old Testament prophets and the bridge between Judaism and Christianity. More commonly, John is known as the "precursor" of our Lord Jesus Christ. All the Gospels report John's basic message Repent, the kingdom is near at hand. One greater than I is coming.

Though he was a wandering preacher who dressed in camel skins and ate grasshoppers, John's legacy is one of true royalty. His origins are similar to those foretold by God through the prophet Isaiah: "You are my servant, he said to me, Israel through whom I show my glory" (Isaiah 49:3). Baricuatro is currently the parochial administrator of St. Thomas More Catholic Church, Paradise, CA. He completed his theological studies at St. Patrick's Seminary and University, Menlo Park, CA. He was ordained a priest by Bishop Soto on May 31, 2010 at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament, Sacramento, CA.

On May 30th we met with Bishop Soto and received my Call to Holy Orders, the final preordination step prior to my Ordination to the Permanent Diaconate on June 30th. I was also given my Parish assignment, which is for one year at St. Maria Goretti in Elk Grove. Gary is blessed to be serving with Father Joshy in a growing parish where he is the lone clergy serving a diverse and growing community. Although, we will continue to attend Mass together at St. Rose of Lima Parish, whenever possible, to share in the Gospel as parishioners of this great community.

Thank you all, for your prayers as this leg of our journey comes to an end and the next leg soon begins. We are truly grateful for your love and support.

The St. Rose Finance Council would like to thank all of you for your on-going generous contributions to support our vibrant ministries. We feel it important to give you an update on several active capital improvement projects the parish has at this time. Because of your generosity, the Parish is able to do these projects without incurring any debt or having an extra capital campaign. How are we able to do this? The money comes from the parish portion of the One Campaign, your generous contributions to the Maintenance Fund and some extraordinary large gifts. You will see our parish balance sheet in the bulletin this week, and we have identified adequate funds to begin work now.

The work and input of several groups within the parish has brought us to this point. A critical group is the Building Committee, consisting of Larry Rowe, Al Foley and Gary Magonigal. Their efforts have been outstanding. Lynne Brys and Jean Ash have contributed their talents to enhance the interior design of our sacred space. The Pastoral Council has been providing input and review of projects and their extra eyes and ears have been invaluable. The Finance Council is in charge with budgeting and review, and their recommendations have been a great assistance to our Pastor. Finally, a big thank you to Fr. Joel Genabia for his leadership on these exciting facility initiatives for our parish community.

Large projects require three (3) bids and prior approval from the Diocese of Sacramento. We are at various stages for four (4) capital improvement projects at this time. The first project you will see is an updated sound and video system for both the Church and the Church Hall. The existing systems are outdated and inadequate. The new system will provide more clarity and evenness in sound and is desperately needed. The video system will offer us expanded capacities to enhance worship and our various activities in the Hall. This project is approved and will happen soon.

The interior of the Church needs a fresh coat of paint and various upgrades. This project has been difficult to assess because of the height of the ceiling and limited access for equipment. A plan has been developed and the Diocese has approved the use of funds. We are assembling bids and more work is needed before we can begin the project. Watch for more updates and timeline.

St. Rose owns a residence adjacent to the Church and it has been the plan for several years to renovate it to be the parish rectory. We have engaged an architect and begun the permitting process with the City. The Diocese has approved the use of funds, but there are several more steps required before bidding and construction can begin. Again watch for more updates and timeline. A shout out to both Ken Grehm and Larry Whitefoot for your exceptional efforts on the rectory project.

The fourth project is to replace floors in the Convent building. This is a smaller project that does not require Diocese approval, and work will be done soon. This is a heavily used facility and new floors will be enjoyed by all.

Large projects take time so we ask for your patience as we begin these improvements. Your continued active service and generosity have made St. Rose a wonderful family parish. With the resources you have so generously provided, we look forward to improving the facility for our use and for future generations to come.

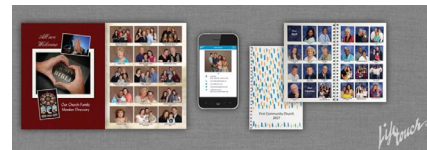


LUNCHES FOR THE HOMELESS

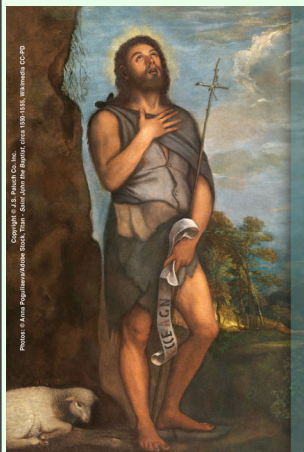

JUAN EL BAUTISTA

Ya que el 24 de junio de este año cae en domingo, la Iglesia tiene la oportunidad para una celebración más vibrante del nacimiento de Juan el Bautista, a quien se le describe como el último de los profetas del Antiguo Testamento y también como el puente entre el judaísmo y el cristianismo. Comúnmente a Juan se le conoce como el "precursor" de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Todos los evangelios narran el mensaje básico de Juan: Arrepiéntanse, el Reino de Dios está cerca. Uno más grande que yo está cerca.

Aunque él era un predicador itinerante, vestido con piel de camello, que comía saltamontes; el legado de Juan es uno de verdadera realeza. Sus orígenes son parecidos a aquellos anunciados por Dios por medio del profeta Isaías "Tú eres mi siervo, Israel; en ti manifestaré mi gloria". La humildad de Juan, "Yo no soy él", fue superada por la de su Señor Jesús, el siervo humilde a quien siguió.

Hoy recordamos a san Juan Bautista, primo de Jesucristo y precursor del Mesías. Juan se hizo famoso predicando la penitencia y bautizando con agua, insistiendo que vendría uno que bautizaría al mundo con fuego y el Espíritu Santo. Hoy es uno de los santos mas festejados en el mundo, especialmente en zonas donde su fiesta coincidía con la llegada del verano.

Para celebrar a este santo pariente de Jesús la gente en Alicante, España, hace fogatas durante la noche de su vigilia y baila en torno a ellas. En América el pueblo Boliviano también recibe al santo con hogueras, para quemar la tierra en busca de fertilidad y purificación. Los Bolivianos también festejan echándose agua los unos a los otros.

San Juan ha sido honrado en el hemisferio Americano desde 1509 cuando Juan Ponce de León nombró la Isla de Puerto Rico en su honor. También allí hacen el juego del agua en la fiesta de san Juan ya que los fieles se echan de espaldas al océano tres veces en busca de purificación y celebración.

Por favor, denle una bienvenida a nuestro nuevo, padre Baricuatro cuando lo vea el primero de julio.

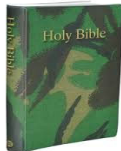

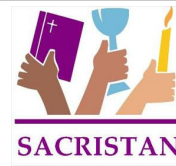
