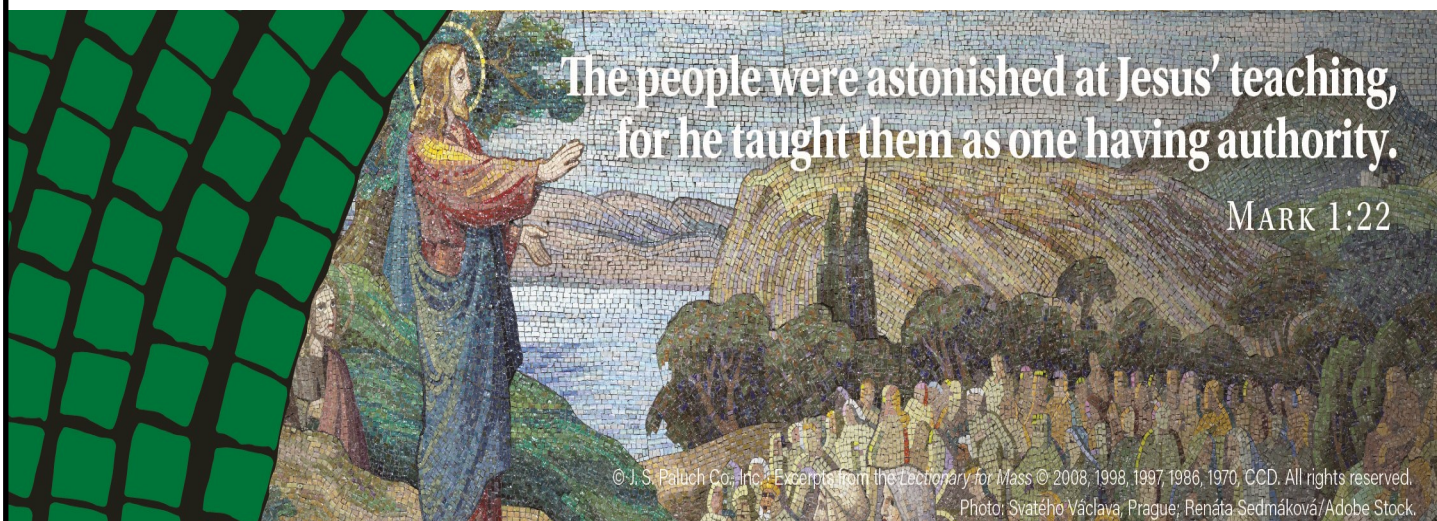

PARISH LITURGY UPDATES

- **Placer County has moved to the purple tier of Governor Newsom's Covid Blueprint, which means all indoor in-person Masses have been suspended.** Due to the unpredictable winter weather, we will only be able to offer livestream Masses, however we will be offering outdoor Holy Communion distribution on Sundays. Join us on our YouTube channel for the livestream Masses: www.youtube.com/saintroseoflimaroseville. Mass times can be found on the front page of this bulletin. Masses are livestreamed and aired via FM107.9 (within a one mile frequency from the church).
- **Holy Communion Distribution:** Anyone who watched the livestream Mass and wishes to receive Holy Communion and has not exhibited any flu-like symptoms or been exposed to Covid are invited to:
 - Drive to the St. Rose of Lima church back parking lot; follow the fence around to form a vehicle Communion line
 - Every occupant in your vehicle is required to wear a face-covering.
 - Ushers will be there to assist the flow of vehicles
 - The priests will approach your vehicle – please do not get out of your car
 - As the priest approaches your vehicle, please make sure your car is in "park" It is important to come to a full stop when you approach the priest and place your vehicle in park.
 - Roll down you window and extend your hands in front of you.
 - The Eucharist must be consumed at the time it is received in your hand.
 - For those who would like to drop off their weekly Offertory, there will be a collection box/basket in the drive-thru Communion line. Thank you for your ongoing support and prayers, as we continue to keep you in our prayers.
- **Confessions:** (new indoor procedure)
 - Saturdays 10-11:00 am
 - Please park in the front parking lot.
 - Four (4) people at a time will be allowed into the church, after having their temperature taken at the side entrance door, closest to the parish office.
 - When more than four people are present they will need to wait outside in their car until it is their turn.
 - A white flag waved will indicate there is room for one more person.

ACTUALIZACIONES DE LA LITURGIA PARROQUIAL

- **El condado de Placer se ha movido al nivel morado del Plan Covid del gobernador Newsom, lo que significa que todas las Misas en persona dentro de la Iglesia han sido suspendidas.** Debido al clima invernal impredecible, solo podremos ofrecer Misas en vivo, sin embargo, estaremos ofreciendo distribución de la Sagrada Comunión al aire libre los domingos. Únase a nosotros en nuestro canal de YouTube para las Misas en vivo: www.youtube.com/saintroseoflimaroseville. Los horarios de Misa se pueden encontrar en la portada de este boletín. Las misas se transmiten en vivo y se transmiten a través de FM107.9 (dentro de una frecuencia de una milla desde los estacionamientos de la iglesia).
- **Distribución de la Sagrada Comunión:** Cualquier persona que haya visto la Misa en vivo y desee recibir la Sagrada Comunión y no haya exhibido ningún síntoma de gripe o haya estado expuesto a Covid está invitado a:
 - Conduzca hasta el estacionamiento trasero de la Iglesia de Sta. Rosa de Lima; siga la cerca para formar una línea de comunión de vehículos
 - Todos los ocupantes de su vehículo deben usar una cubre-cara.
 - Los servidores estarán allí para ayudar al flujo de vehículos.
 - Los sacerdotes se acercarán a su vehículo; por favor, no salga de su automóvil.
 - Cuando el sacerdote se acerque a su vehículo, asegúrese de que su automóvil esté en "estacionamiento". Es importante detenerse por completo cuando se acerque al sacerdote y estacionar su vehículo.
 - Baja la ventana y extiende tus manos frente a ti.
 - La Eucaristía debe consumirse en el momento en que se recibe en su mano.
 - Para aquellos que deseen dejar su ofertorio semanal, habrá una caja / canasta de recolección disponible. Gracias por su continuo apoyo y oraciones, mientras continuamos manteniéndolos en nuestras oraciones.
- **Confesiones:** (nuevo procedimiento)
 - Sábados de 10:00 a 11:00 am
 - Estacionese en el estacionamiento de enfrente.
 - Se permitirá la entrada a la Iglesia de cuatro (4) personas a la vez, después de tomarse la temperatura en la puerta de entrada lateral, más cercana a la oficina parroquial.
 - Cuando haya más de cuatro personas presentes, deberán esperar afuera en su automóvil hasta que sea su turno.
 - Una bandera blanca ondeando indicará que hay espacio para una persona más.

Candlemas/The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord:

is Tuesday, February 2nd. We purchased candles which will be blessed at the Mass and available for a donation of \$5.00 each (to cover the expense) on Sunday, February 7th; if you would like one to take home for personal and family use! A great reminder that we can always find hope in Christ the Light of the World to any challenge we may face! Or if you have your own candle blessed; please bring it with you in the car on Sunday February 7th.

St. Blaise Memorial/Blessing of the Throats: is Wednesday, February 3rd. Although we can't gather in person, you will receive a Blessing of the Throat via the livestreamed Masses 7:30 am (English) & 6:30 pm (Spanish) when you participate by viewing the Mass.

Looking Ahead to Lent:

Ash Wednesday is February 17th. Masses will be celebrated through livestream at 7:30 AM (English) and 6:30 PM (Spanish). They will also be transmitted via FM station 107.9, for those who would like to park in the front church parking lot to listen and participate. Holy Communion and the Imposition of the Ashes will be distributed in the front lot shortly after both of the Masses are celebrated. For those who view the 7:30 AM English livestreamed Mass from home, distribution of Ashes and Communion will move to the back parking lot at 8:45 AM and be available until 9:15 AM

Livestreamed Bilingual Stations of the Cross will be Fridays during Lent at 6:00 PM with a livestreamed Holy Hour following from 6:30-7:30 PM. During the Holy Hour we will pray the Bilingual Liturgy of the Hour Evening Prayers

We will journey together during the Lenten Season with a program from FORMED. This is a great way to prepare for the Lenten season and it is free to all parishioners. Please look for more details coming out soon.

Candelaria / Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor: es el martes 2 de febrero. La Sagrada Comunión y la Imposición de las Cenizas se distribuirán en el estacionamiento del frente poco después de que se celebren las dos Misas. Para aquellos que vean la Misa en vivo en Inglés de las 7:30 AM. Desde su casa, la distribución de Cenizas y Comunión se trasladará al estacionamiento trasero a las 8:45 AM y estará disponible hasta las 9:15 AM.

St. Rose of Lima Parish Bible Study Beginning in January!

You are invited to join the Bible Study Team for an online (Zoom) Bible Study beginning in late January. *Lectio Philippians: Life in Christ* is a 6-week series that is a part of the Formed content available for free to all parishioners.

Toward the end of his life, under arrest and awaiting trial in Rome, St. Paul wrote a short but powerful letter to the Philippians. With his words and the example of his life, Paul exhorts the Philippians to have the mind of Christ, to live a life worthy of the Gospel, and, by God's grace, to gain Christ. In 6 sessions, Dr. Tim Gray combines insight and practical guidance using lectio divina disciplines to make the Scriptures come alive in Philippians: Life in Christ.

The study discussion will be offered at two different times:

- Tuesdays from 10:00-11:30 a.m. beginning January 26, and ending March 9 (with one break week). To sign up for the Tuesday morning sessions, please email Liz Clingman at liz5011@icloud.com.

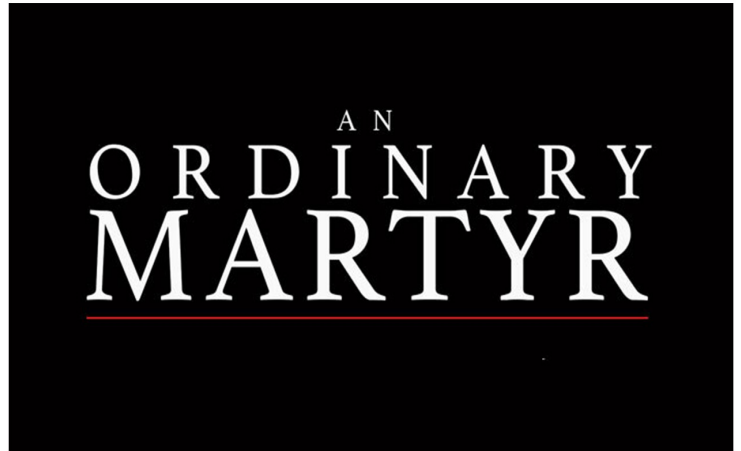

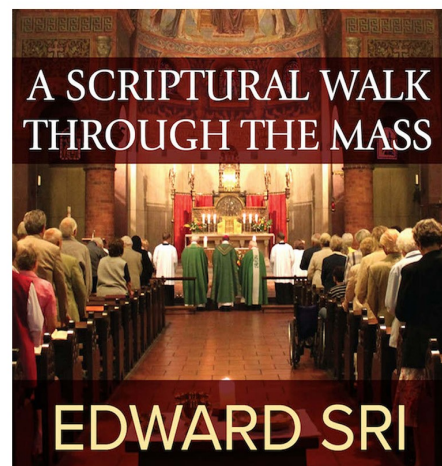

The Year of St. Joseph

December 8, 2020-December 8, 2021

On December 8, 2020, Pope Francis declared a special Year of St. Joseph to run through December 8, 2021. This marks the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX. Pope Francis began the year with a new Apostolic Letter entitled *Patris Corde* (With a Father's Heart).

The Holy Father reflected that Covid-19 "has helped us see more clearly the importance of ordinary people who, though far from the limelight exercise patience and offer hope every day". St. Joseph is the epitome of the quiet, ordinary person moving behind the scenes – and yet he shapes all of human history with his quiet guidance, protection, holiness, and acceptance of God's will.

Plenary Indulgence

The Pope also issued a decree granting plenary indulgences for the duration of the special year to celebrate the anniversary and "to perpetuate the entrustment of the whole Church to the powerful patronage of the Custodian of Jesus." The plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions) to Christians who, with a spirit detached from any sin, participate in the Year of St. Joseph on these occasions and manners indicated by the Apostolic Penitentiary:

- The plenary indulgence is granted to those who will meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, or take part in a Spiritual Retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph. "St. Joseph, an authentic man of faith, invites us", the decree reads, "to rediscover our filial relationship with the Father, to renew fidelity to prayer, to listen and correspond with profound discernment to God's will."
- The indulgence can also be obtained by those who, following St. Joseph's example, will perform a spiritual or corporal work of mercy. St. Joseph "encourages us to rediscover the value of silence, prudence and loyalty in carrying out our duties," the decree notes.
- The recitation of the Holy Rosary in families and among engaged couples is another way of obtaining indulgences, in order that "all Christian families may be stimulated to recreate the same atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer that was in the Holy Family."
- Everyone who entrusts their daily activity to the protection of St. Joseph, and every faithful who invokes the intercession of St. Joseph so that those seeking work can find dignifying work can also obtain the plenary indulgence. On 1 May 1955, Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of St. Joseph "with the intent that the dignity of work be recognized by all, and that it inspires social life and laws, based on the fair distribution of rights and duties."
- The plenary indulgence is also granted to the faithful who will recite the Litany to St. Joseph (for the Latin tradition), or the Akathistos to St. Joseph (for the Byzantine tradition), or any other prayer to St. Joseph proper to the other liturgical traditions, for the persecuted Church ad intra and ad extra, and for the relief of all Christians suffering all forms of persecution. Because, the decree notes, "the flight of the Holy Family to Egypt shows us that God is there where man is in danger, where man suffers, where he runs away, where he experiences rejection and abandonment."

Prayer to St. Joseph

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

To you God entrusted his only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became man.

Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life.

Obtain for us grace, mercy, courage, and defend us from evil.

El año de San José

8 de diciembre de 2020 al 8 de diciembre de 2021

El 8 de diciembre de 2020, el Papa Francisco declaró un Año especial de San José hasta el 8 de diciembre de 2021. Esto marca el 150 aniversario de la declaración de San José como Patrón de la Iglesia Universal por el Papa Pío IX. El Papa Francisco comenzó el año con una nueva Carta Apostólica titulada *Patris Corde* (Con corazón de padre). El Santo Padre reflexionó que el Covid-19 “nos ha ayudado a ver más claramente la importancia de la gente corriente que, aunque lejos del centro de atención, ejerce la paciencia y ofrece

cada día esperanza”. San José es el epítome de la persona tranquila y ordinaria que se mueve detrás de escena y, sin embargo, da forma a toda la historia de la humanidad con su silenciosa guía, protección, santidad y aceptación de la voluntad de Dios.

Indulgencia Plenaria

El Papa también emitió un decreto concediendo indulgencias plenarias durante el año especial para celebrar el aniversario y “para perpetuar la encomienda de toda la Iglesia al poderoso patrocinio del Custodio de Jesús”. La indulgencia plenaria se concede a los fieles en las condiciones habituales (confesión sacramental, comunión eucarística y oración por las intenciones del Papa) a los cristianos que, con espíritu desprendido de cualquier pecado, participan en estas ocasiones en el Año de San José y modales indicados por la Penitenciaría Apostólica:

- La indulgencia plenaria se concede a quienes mediten durante al menos 30 minutos en el Padrenuestro o participen en un Retiro Espiritual de al menos un día que incluya una meditación sobre San José. “San José, auténtico hombre de fe, nos invita”, reza el decreto, “a redescubrir nuestra relación filial con el Padre, a renovar la fidelidad a la oración, a escuchar y corresponder con profundo discernimiento a la voluntad de Dios”.
- La indulgencia también la pueden obtener quienes, siguiendo el ejemplo de San José, realizarán una obra de misericordia espiritual o corporal. San José “nos anima a redescubrir el valor del silencio, la prudencia y la lealtad en el desempeño de nuestros deberes”, señala el decreto.
- El rezo del Santo Rosario en las familias y entre los novios es otra forma de obtener indulgencias, para que “todas las familias cristianas se sientan estimuladas a recrear el mismo clima de comunión íntima, amor y oración que había en la Sagrada Familia”.
- También puede obtener la indulgencia plenaria todo aquel que confía su actividad diaria a la protección de San José, y todo fiel que invoca la intercesión de San José para que quien busca trabajo encuentre un trabajo digno. El 1 de mayo de 1955, el Papa Pío XII instituyó la fiesta de San José “con la intención de que la dignidad del trabajo sea reconocida por todos, e inspire la vida social y las leyes, basadas en la justa distribución de derechos y deberes”.
- La indulgencia plenaria también se concede a los fieles que reciten la Letanía a San José (para la tradición latina), o el Akathistos a San José (para la tradición bizantina), o cualquier otra oración a San José propia de las otras tradiciones litúrgicas, para la Iglesia perseguida ad intra y ad extra, y para el alivio de todos los cristianos que sufren todas las formas de persecución. Porque, señala el decreto, “la huida de la Sagrada Familia a Egipto nos muestra que Dios está allí donde el hombre está en peligro, donde el hombre sufre, donde huye, donde experimenta el rechazo y el abandono”.

Oración a San José

Salve, custodio del Redentor y esposo de la Virgen María.

A ti Dios confió a su Hijo, en ti María depositó su confianza, contigo Cristo se forjó como hombre.

Oh, bienaventurado José, muéstrate padre también a nosotros y guíanos en el camino de la vida.

Concédenos gracia, misericordia y valentía, y defiéndenos de todo mal.
