INDULGENCES

An indulgence, according to the Roman Catholic Church, is a means of remission of the temporal punishment for sins which have already been forgiven but are due to the Christian in this life and/or in purgatory. This punishment is most often in purgatory but can also be suffered in this life. An indulgence removes time needed to be spent in purgatory.

Your chance to help your relatives in Purgatory!

The Church has granted daily indulgences (one per day) from November 1-8 inclusive, for the departed souls, plenary if all the conditions are fulfilled, partial otherwise You must have the INTENTION and pray for the Holy Father (one Hail Mary and Glory be will do)

The conditions are:

- 1) Pray in a cemetery or mausoleum
- 2) Receive Holy Communion that day
- 3) Receive sacramental confession about 20 days before or after
- 4) Be in a state of grace
- 5) Plenary indulgence if all attachment to sin (even venial) is absent, partial otherwise All November is set aside for remembrances and prayers for the Holy Souls!!
