From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus is confronted by a group of Sadducees attempting to embarrass him regarding the resurrection of the dead. They denied the resurrection of the dead, the existence of spirits, and the validity of oral tradition. They accepted only the written law.

The Sadducees come with a situation where a woman has seven husbands but no offspring. When the woman died, who or how many of those seven would be her husband at the resurrection of the dead? Remember, the Sadducees do not even believe in the resurrection of the dead. They also have a very shallow understanding of what marriage was about. Their motive was to make Jesus look foolish. Jesus' response. The first point Jesus makes in his response is the most important one: Marriage and all it involves takes place during life on earth, in this age. In the coming age, the practices and understandings related to life here and now no longer apply.


Those who experience the resurrection of the dead live in a setting unlike anything previously experienced in this world's here and now life. There will be no marriage and no dying in heaven. Jesus finishes off the Sadducees by making reference to Moses, whom they do accept. He declares that Moses testified to the reality of the resurrection by referring to the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob as the God of the living—even though all had been dead for centuries.
