Dear Parishioners,

Allow me to point out that Friday, March 17th is the commemoration of St. Patrick. Bishop Guglielmone has dispensed the requirement to abstain from meat on that day — but asks that anyone accepting this dispensation perform some work of charity. I ask that people bringing food to the church bring only simple meatless dishes for the meal following the stations.

Friday, March 24th, we will have the Stations at St. Luke's at 6:30, as usual. At Holy Cross at 5:15, however, I will celebrate the Vigil Mass of the Solemnity of the Annunciation. Immediately after Mass, we will share a simple meal provided by parishioners. After eating enough to defer the pangs of hunger, probably around 6:20, I will start hearing confessions for as long as people come.

The 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent (Mar 19 & 26, & Apr 2) will include the "Scrutinies" for non-baptized adults preparing to enter the Church. These will be included at the 11:30 Mass at Holy Cross. Please keep in your prayers all preparing for Baptism at Easter, and also for previously baptized persons preparing to profess the Catholic faith and be confirmed at Pentecost.
