HOW TO REPORT ALLEGATIONS OF SEXUAL ABUSE

**If you suspect abuse has occurred
within a family:**

Contact the Department of Social
Services within the county the
abuse took place.

Contact the Diocese, to report status
at (843) 261-0430.

**If you suspect an abuse has
occurred that involved diocesan
personnel (priests, deacons,
teachers, employees or
volunteers) contact:**

**The facilities of St. Luke are available
to all ACTIVE parishioners. This
includes the use of the church for all
Sacramental events. Active
Membership is determined as follows:**

1. Registered in the parish for 6 months.
2. Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.
3. Financial support of the church according to your means.

Baptism: Parents must complete training prior to having a child baptized. Please call the parish office to schedule a meeting with the Pastor.

Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the priest regardless of location of wedding.

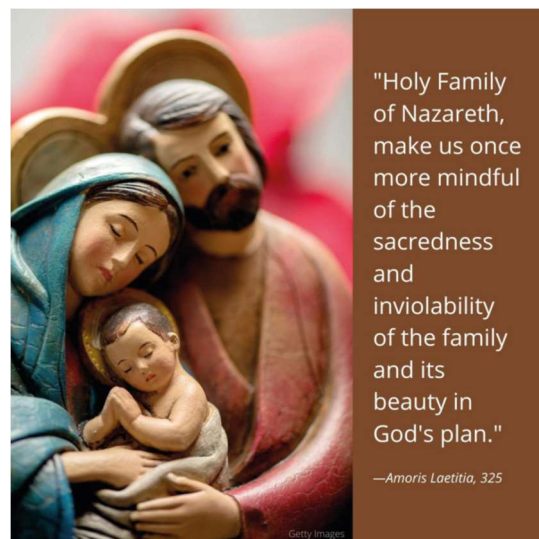


We would like to extend our sincere appreciation to all who work to make our parish life a little easier throughout the year.
