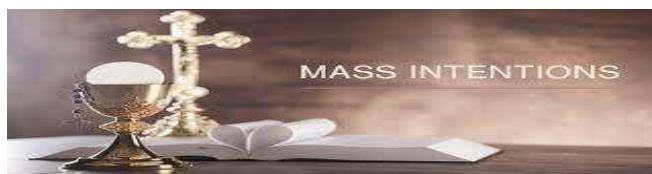

What is the Eucharist?

Dear family of St Brendan and St George,

Last Sunday, I shared an article about Mass intentions with you. I hope we begin to understand and value our incredible blessings of the Eucharist, that sometimes we don't realize. I want to increase our understanding of the mystery of the Eucharist as the heart of all the sacraments and our faith; for this reason, Jesus said: Do this in memory of me. Let us illustrate through some Saints how they saw and experienced the Eucharist so that they may inspire us with faith in devotion every time we gather around the table. St. Leonard wrote about the "Tremendous value of the Holy Mass", saying that, "at the hour of death, the Holy Masses you have heard devoutly will be your greatest consolation." He says that God forgives you all the venial sins which you are determined to avoid.

In the Eucharist, God forgives us of all our unknown sins, which we never confessed. The power of Satan over us is diminished. Every Mass will go and count us to the final judgment and plead for pardon. Through each Mass participation, we can diminish the temporal punishment due to our sins, according to our fervor. Our Lord Jesus Christ supplies many of your negligence and omissions through the Holy Sacrifice. If you are attending Mass piously, you afford the Souls in Purgatory the most significant possible relief. For this reason, one Holy Mass heard during your life will benefit you more than many heard for you after your death.

Sometimes we are tempted to seek "good luck" in our lives and forget about different things through esoteric practices. We forget that through Holy Mass, we are preserved from many dangers and misfortunes that would otherwise have occurred. Also, Purgatory is shortened by every Mass you attend. Remember also that during the Holy Mass, we kneel amid a multitude of holy Angels present at that moment of the Eucharist. St. Padre Pio used to say that there is nothing as great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, he would have given it to us. St. John Vianey noted that the Mass is the most form of prayer. St John Chrysostom said a single mass offered for oneself during life might be worth more than a thousand celebrated for the same intention after death.

May the teaching of the Saints about the Eucharist help us to value the Eucharist and inspires our love and pity for the great gift that Jesus Christ has given in this Sacrament.

¿Qué es la Eucaristía?

Querida familia de San Brendan y San Jorge,

El domingo pasado, compartí con ustedes un artículo sobre la intención de la Misa. Espero que empecemos a comprender y valorar nuestras increíbles bendiciones, ya veces no nos damos cuenta de la Eucaristía. Quiero aumentar nuestra comprensión del misterio de la Eucaristía como el corazón de todos los sacramentos y de nuestra fe; por eso Jesús dijo: Haced esto en memoria mía. Ilustremos a través de algunos santos cómo vieron y experimentaron la Eucaristía para que nos inspiren la fe en la devoción cada vez que nos reunamos alrededor de la mesa. San Leonardo escribió sobre el "Tremendo valor de la Santa Misa," diciendo que "en la hora de la muerte, las Santas Misas que has escuchado con devoción serán tu mayor consuelo." Dice que Dios os perdona todos los pecados veniales que estáis decididos a evitar.

En la Eucaristía, Dios nos perdona todos nuestros pecados desconocidos, que nunca confesamos. El poder de Satanás sobre nosotros disminuye. Cada Misa irá y nos contará hasta el juicio final y pedirá perdón. A través de cada participación en la Misa, podemos disminuir el castigo temporal debido a nuestros pecados, según nuestro fervor. Nuestro Señor Jesucristo suple muchas de vuestras negligencias y omisiones a través del Santo Sacrificio. Si estás durante la Misa piadosamente, les brindas a las Almas del Purgatorio el alivio más significativo posible. Por eso, una Santa Misa escuchada durante tu vida te beneficiará más que muchas escuchadas por ti después de tu muerte.

A veces nos vemos tentados a buscar la "buena suerte" en nuestra vida y nos olvidamos de diferentes cosas a través de prácticas esotéricas. Olvidamos que a través de la Santa Misa somos preservados de muchos peligros y desgracias que de otro modo habrían ocurrido. Además, acortamos su Purgatorio por cada Misa. Recuerda también que durante la Santa Misa, nos arrodillamos en medio de una multitud de santos Ángeles presentes en el momento de la Eucaristía. San Padre Pio solía decir que no hay nada más grande que la Eucaristía. Si Dios tuviera algo más precioso, nos lo habría dado. San Juan Vianey señaló que la Misa es la mayor forma de oración. San Juan Crisóstomo decía que una sola misa ofrecida por uno mismo en vida podía valer más que mil celebradas por la misma intención después de la muerte.

Que la enseñanza de los Santos sobre la Eucaristía nos ayude a valorar la Eucaristía e inspire nuestro amor y piedad por el gran don que Jesucristo nos ha dado en este Sacramento.

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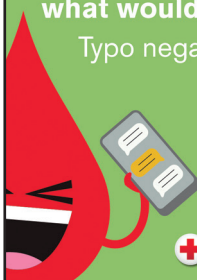
