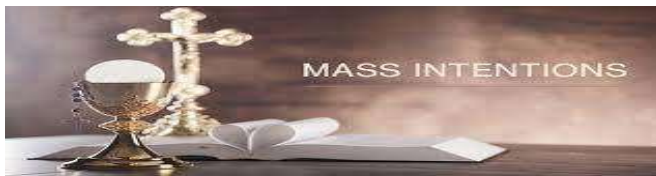

Dear Family of St. Brendan & St. George,

The greatest and most important Feast for Christian Catholics has arrived; let us prepare and be part of each celebration by knowing our Faith.

Holy Week is the most important time for Christians throughout the world. Holy Week, the final week of Lent, begins on Palm Sunday, the Sunday before Easter. Holy Week is when Catholics gather to remember and participate in the Passion of Jesus Christ. The Passion was the final period of Christ's life in Jerusalem. It spans from when He arrived in Jerusalem to when He was crucified.

How Do Catholics Celebrate Holy Week?

Four special ceremonies commemorate the events of Christ's Passion, from His entrance into Jerusalem, when palm branches were placed in His path, through His arrest on Holy Thursday and Crucifixion on Good Friday, to Holy Saturday, the day that Christ's body lay in the tomb. The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are:

- ❖ **Holy Thursday** commemorates the Last Supper when Jesus consecrated bread and wine. The washing of the feet occurs during this Mass as well. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist will follow.
- ❖ **Good Friday** is one of the darkest days of the year for Catholics. It covers Jesus' arrest, trial, and crucifixion. His death and burial are also memorialized. This will be portrayed by the Living Stations and Adoration of the Cross. Good Friday is a day of fasting within the Church. Traditionally, there is no Mass or celebration of the Eucharist on Good Friday. Communion comes from hosts consecrated on Holy Thursday. Church bells are silent. Altars are left bare. The solemn, muted atmosphere is preserved until the Easter Vigil.
- ❖ **Holy Saturday** remembers the day which Jesus spent in the grave resting and is celebrated at the **Easter Vigil**. This is the most important celebration during Holy Week. Do not miss and experience the new resurrection in your Life in Jesus Christ. There is no other celebration in the whole year that is richer in blessing with the blessing to the Fire as Jesus, the light of the World. After the conclusion of the Liturgy of the Word, the water of the baptismal font is solemnly blessed, and any catechumens and candidates for full communion are initiated into the church.

My dear friends, come, join us and celebrate the most important feasts of our Faith. Please refer to the Holy Week schedule on the following page for additional events and times.

Querida familia de St. Brendan y St. George,

Ha llegado la gran y más importante Fiesta para los cristianos católicos; preparémonos y seamos parte de cada celebración conociendo nuestra fe.

La Semana Santa es el momento más importante para los cristianos en todo el mundo. La Semana Santa, la última semana de Cuaresma, comienza el Domingo de Ramos, el domingo anterior a la Pascua. La Semana Santa es cuando los católicos se reúnen para recordar y participar en la Pasión de Jesucristo. La Pasión fue el período final de la vida de Cristo en Jerusalén. Abarca desde que llegó a Jerusalén hasta que fue crucificado.

¿Cómo celebran los católicos la Semana Santa?

Cuatro ceremonias especiales conmemoran los acontecimientos de la Pasión de Cristo, desde Su entrada en Jerusalén, cuando se colocaron ramas de palma en Su camino, pasando por Su arresto el Jueves Santo y la Crucifixión el Viernes Santo, hasta el Sábado Santo, día en que el cuerpo de Cristo yacía en el sepulcro. La cumbre del Año Litúrgico es el **Triduo Pascual**, desde la tarde del Jueves Santo hasta la tarde del Domingo de Pascua. Aunque cronológicamente son tres días, litúrgicamente son un día desplegando para nosotros la unidad del Misterio Pascual de Cristo. La única celebración del Triduo marca el final del tiempo de Cuaresma y conduce a la Misa de la Resurrección del Señor en la Vigilia Pascual. Los servicios litúrgicos que tienen lugar durante el Triduo son:

- ❖ El **Jueves Santo** conmemoraba la Última Cena cuando Jesús consagró el pan y el vino. El lavatorio de los pies se lleva a cabo durante Misa de la Cena del Señor, seguida de la Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento de la Eucaristía.
- ❖ El **Viernes Santo** es uno de los días más oscuros del año para los católicos. Cubre el arresto, el juicio y la crucifixión de Jesús. También se conmemora su muerte y entierro. Los eventos del **Viernes Santo** son las Vía Crucis y adoración de la Cruz. El Viernes Santo es un día de ayuno dentro de la Iglesia. Tradicionalmente, no hay Misa ni celebración de la Eucaristía el Viernes Santo. La comunión proviene de las hostias consagradas el Jueves Santo. Las campanas de la iglesia están en silencio. Los altares se dejan desnudos. El ambiente solemne y apagado se conserva hasta la Vigilia Pascual.
- ❖ El **Sábado Santo** recuerda el día que Jesús pasó descansando en el sepulcro y los celebramos durante la **Vigilia Pascual**. Esta es la celebración más importante durante la Semana Santa. No te pierdas y experimenta la nueva resurrección en tu Vida en Jesucristo. No hay otra celebración en todo el año más rica en bendición con la bendición al Fuego que Jesús, la luz del Mundo. Después de la conclusión de la Liturgia de la Palabra, se bendice solemnemente el agua de la pila bautismal y se inicia en la iglesia a los catecúmenos y candidatos a la plena comunión.

Mis queridos amigos, vengan, únanse a nosotros y celebren las fiestas más importantes de nuestra Fe.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7

In a tone of quiet sadness, Isaiah describes the buffets and insults given to the Suffering Servant. The passage ends on a note of hope.

Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

In exultant tones, Paul tells the Philippians to rejoice because Christ became man, died on the cross, rose from the dead, and sits triumphantly at the right hand of the Father.

Gospel: Matthew 26:14—27:66

This is the solemn narrative of the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Matthew recounts the treachery and betrayal of Judas and then describes the events of the Last Supper, culminating in the institution of the Eucharist. Jesus endures the Agony in the Garden; he is then brought before Caiaphas and Pilate and condemned to death. After His resurrection, the centurions shouted, "Clearly this was the Son of God!"

Primera Lectura: Isaías 50:4-7

En un tono de calma tristeza, Isaías describe los golpes e insultos dados al Siervo que Sufre. Este pasaje termina con un rayo de esperanza.

Segunda Lectura: Filipenses 2:6-11

Con gran gozo Pablo les dice a los filipenses que se regocijen pues Cristo se convirtió en hombre, murió en la cruz, se levantó de entre los muertos y está triunfalmente sentado a la derecha del Padre.

Evangelio: San Mateo 26:14—27:66

Esta es la solemne narrativa de la pasión y muerte de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Mateo cuenta de la traición de Judas y luego describe los eventos de la Última Cena, culminando con la institución de la Eucaristía. Jesús soporta la agonía en el Jardín, luego es llevado frente a Caifás y Pilatos, y condenado a muerte. Luego de su resurrección, los centuriones gritaron: "¡En verdad este era el Hijo de Dios!"

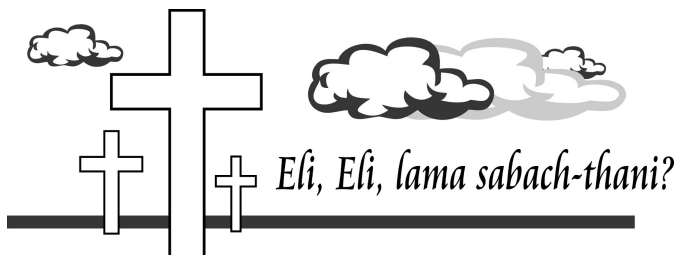

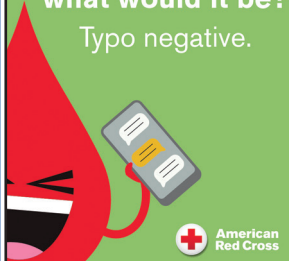
