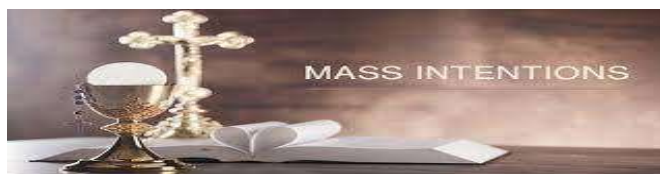

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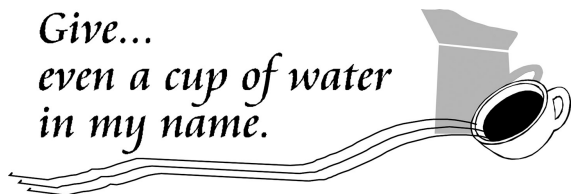

Dear Family of St Brendan & St George,

Last Sunday, we had, for the first time, a healing Mass at 10:30am & 1pm. For some of us, this is something new and we may be unaware of all the blessings we can receive in the Eucharist. I would like us to reflect on it so that we may grow stronger each day in our faith and in our devotion to the Eucharist. This will help us to receive all the blessings and the healing that our body, mind, and spirit needs. This Liturgical Year is the year of the Eucharist. Our goal is that through the following articles, we will learn and connect more deeply to the Holy Eucharist.

II Chronicles 5, 11-14

The priests left the Holy Place. All the present priests had purified themselves regardless of the shifts they were distributing. All the singing Levites, Asaph, Heman, and Jedutun, together with their sons and other relatives, stood to the east of the altar, dressed in linen. They had cymbals, psalteries, and harps. With them were one hundred and twenty priests who blew trumpets. Then all together they began to play the trumpets and sing with one voice to praise and give thanks to the Lord, sounding the trumpets, the cymbals and the other musical instruments while they sang: "Praise the Lord, for he is good, for his love is eternal." At that moment, the temple of the Lord was filled with a cloud, and because of the cloud the priests could not stay to celebrate, because the glory of the Lord had filled the temple.

This shows that where God was present was a holy and healing place. When we become aware of this, the healing process begins. If this happened in a place where there were elements representative of God, how much more does it happen in the temple, where the sacramental presence of God himself remains? Our temples are places of healing and unfortunately we are not always mindful of this. The blessing that is in our temple, in the Eucharist, is a supernatural reality. The Mass contains all the spiritual good of the Church: Jesus Christ, who associates his Church, and all his members, to his paschal sacrifice, offered once for all on the cross to the Father; and, through this sacrifice, he pours out the grace of salvation on his Body, which is the Church.

Let us reflect on what happens at the very start of the Mass. When we enter the church, the first thing we do is make the sign of the cross over ourselves with holy water, which is ***blessed in the name of the church to heal and cast out demons.***

Please prepare for next week's reflection by reading Ezekiel 9,5-6 and Revelation 7,3. In next weeks bulletin we will continue our study on the structure of the Eucharist and learn more about the Sign of the Cross.

May we begin today, to value and love the greatest blessing that Jesus has given us in the Holy Eucharist.

Querida familia de San Brendan y San Jorge,

El domingo pasado tuvimos, por primera vez, oficialmente una Misa de sanación en la Eucaristía a las 10:30 AM y 1:00 PM. Para algunos de nosotros, esto es algo que puede ser nuevo o desconocer todas las bendiciones que podemos recibir en la Eucaristía. Por eso, quisiera reflexionar sobre ello para que cada día se fortalezca nuestra devoción y fe en cada Eucaristía para que estemos recibiendo todas las bendiciones y sanaciones que nuestro Cuerpo, mente y espíritu necesitan. Además, este año es llamado el año dedicado a la Eucaristía. Nuestro objetivo es que a través de los siguientes artículos, conozcamos más profundamente acerca de la Sagrada Eucaristía.

II de crónicas 5, 11-14

Los sacerdotes salieron del Lugar Santo. Todos los sacerdotes que estaban presentes se habían purificado sin atenerse a los turnos en que estaban repartidos. Todos los levitascantores, Asaf, Hemán y Jedutún, junto con sus hijos y demás parientes, estaban de pie, al este del altar, vestidos de lino. Tenían platillos, salterios y arpas. Con ellos había ciento veintea sacerdotes que tocaban trompetas. Entonces todos unidos se pusieron a tocar las trompetas ya cantar a una voz para alabar y dar gracias al Señor, haciendo sonar las trompetas, los platillos y los otros instrumentos musicales mientras se cantaba: "Alaben al Señor, porque es bueno, porque su amor es eterno." En aquel momento, el templo del Señor se llenó de una nube, y por causa de la nube los sacerdotes no pudieron quedarse para celebrar el culto, porque la gloria del Señor había llenado el templo.

Esta versículo muestra que donde Dios estaba presente ese era un lugar santo y de curación. Cuando tomamos conciencia de ello, empieza el proceso de curación.

Si esto ocurría en un lugar donde habían elementos que eran representativos de Dios, ¿cuánto más ocurre en el templo, donde permanece la presencia sacramentada de Dios mismo? Nuestros templos son lugares de sanación y lamentablemente no somos conscientes de ello. La bendición que hay en nuestros templos y en la eucaristía es una realidad sobrenatural. La misa, contiene todo el bien espiritual de la Iglesia: Jesucristo, que asocia a su Iglesia, y a todos sus miembros, a su sacrificio pascual, ofrecido una vez portados en la cruz al Padre; y, por medio de este sacrificio, derrama la gracia de la salvación sobre su Cuerpo que es la Iglesia.

Comencemos a ver qué sucede desde el comienzo de la misa. Cuando entramos a la iglesia, lo primero que hacemos es hacernos la señal de la cruz nosotros mismos con agua bendita, la cual está bendita en nombre de la iglesia para sanar y echar fuera demonios.

En Nuestro siguiente boletín, comenzaremos a estudiar la estructura de la Eucaristía. Que comencemos a valorar y amar la mayor bendición que Jesús nos ha dado en la Sagrada Eucaristía.

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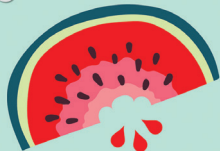
