All Souls Day

November 2nd is All Souls Day commemorating the faithful departed. You are invited to join us for our annual All Souls Day Mass at 6pm. We will continue our tradition of reverently placing a small photograph of your deceased loved ones in front of the sanctuary before the Mass. Please arrive between 5:30pm-5:45pm to place your photographs. After the Mass, we will open the catacombs and cemetery for visitation and prayer.

ADULT THEOLOGY CLASSES

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a year-long program that prepares people to receive all or some of the sacraments of initiation (baptism, confirmation, communion). The program culminates with the reception of these sacraments at the Easter Vigil. Gospel: Mark 10:46-52

As Jesus was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a sizable crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind man, the son of Timaeus, sat by the roadside begging. On hearing that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he kept calling out all the more, "Son of David, have pity on me." Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.


- Encourage intentional, sustained giving from our entire community


