BEGINS IN SEPTEMBER!

In June 2023 we received 68 calls on the helpline. From those calls we helped 23 households (26 adults and 16 children).

One woman was recently homeless and now trying to move to an apartment with her sister. They would share expenses including rent. Having just started a new job, she could not afford the deposit and the first month's rent. We were able to help with the deposit and some furniture. She was so grateful and now able to move forward in her life.

We see so many disabled and/or elderly people who live on a limited income, usually around a \$1,000 a month. They have no ability to work due to age or disability. Their income provides no extra money for unexpected expenses. With your help, we can step in and help these neighbors when that \$1,000 just does not cover even basic needs.
