

- ★ During the 2022-2023 school year, SMCS was fortunate enough to receive a tabernacle to host the Blessed Sacrament and a beautiful wooden statue of St. Michael. Hand carved wooden stands were built to hold both the tabernacle and the statue.
- ★ In the fall of 2023, SMCS started to have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the School Chapel every other week for students and staff.


★ Strengths from our Accreditation Visit Report


Academic Excellence

- ★ SMCS teachers and staff work collaboratively with Mr. Muzyka to plan and implement classroom and testing accommodations for students with diagnosed learning differences.


NWEA Reading Scores







Academic Excellence

★ Strengths from our Accreditation Visit Report

- SMCS uses effective instructional strategies and instructional technology to enhance learning and understanding through student work, anchor charts, use of individual chrome books and instructional software, and effective use of SMART boards and document cameras.
- SMCS has an excellent system for developing, sharing, and monitoring Catholic Accommodation plans to ensure teacher accountability and increased student success. Faculty differentiate learning through the use of one to one, small group instruction, reteaching, and peer learning.

★ Strengths from our Accreditation Visit Report

- School guidance programs and curricula are a strength. Students receive dynamic instruction using high quality materials both from the counselor and from the classroom teachers. The guidance program fosters the students' overall well being, academic success, and a Christian community.
- SMCS has an excellent extracurricular program including spiritual, fine arts, and athletic activities for students in all grade levels that contribute to the strong feeling of community in the school.

Operational Vitality

- ★ School safety and security is always a top priority.
 - We have an off duty police officer on campus from 7 am to 4 pm every day. We also have an officer that is in the back of church when we are at Mass.
 - Off duty police officers are also present during busy school activities such as Parent Lunch Day, the Halloween Carnival, Middle School Dances, Christmas Programs, Snow White, the Spring Musical, 8th Grade Graduation.


Operational Vitality

- ★ During August 2023, SMCS replaced all of its AEDs.

2nd Grade Fire Exits


Updated Track and AEDs










Operational Vitality

★ Strengths from our Accreditation Visit Report

- School security is a strength of the school with a continued emphasis on safety as a priority. Security measures include officers throughout the day and multiple officers and at arrival and dismissal, various secure entry points before accessing student areas, gate enhancements, newly installed fire exits, and the installation of the ballistic film.
- The school provides and implements safety training for students, faculty, and staff on emergency and safety procedures including attendance at the Texas School Safety Conference and the implementation of Raptor alert system.

A look ahead to the 2024-2025 School Year

- ★ All School Mass will continue but we will move Mass day to Wednesday. We will continue to go two times during weeks when there is a Holy Day of Obligation that does not fall on a Wednesday.
- ★ We will have a new uniform company-Flynn O'Hara. This is the company that was able to help the school with skirts at the beginning of the school year.
 - The school uniform is not changing.
- ★ We will bring back birthday lunch for students and parents. Parents will be invited to have lunch with their student on their birthday or designated birthday celebration day. Due to limited spacing, these birthday lunches will be limited to parents only (no siblings please).
