#### 2. Rooted in God's word

- "When you read God's Word, you must constantly be saying to yourself, 'It is talking to me, and about me.'" Soren Kierkegaard
- How often do you sit down and read the bible?
- Imagine: God's word can work on us even when we may not be aware of it. We may not always understand or comprehend it, but God's word can change us.
- The Bible is essential to living a solid Catholic spiritual life.
- Decide today: **I will commit to reading the Holy Bible, even if it's just one verse.** Do it with the expectancy that God is going to speak to you.
- Practice:** For at least five minutes each day, read the Acts of the Apostles.
