

He says: "Behold I am with you always," "I have loved you with an everlasting love, so I am constant in my affection for you" (Mt 28:30; Jer 31:3). "The visit to the Blessed Sacrament ... is a great treasure of the Catholic faith. It nourishes social love and gives us opportunities for adoration and thanksgiving, for reparation and supplication ... Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament [is] ... in full accord with the teaching of the Second Vatican Council" (From Missionaries of the Blessed Sacrament What is the Eucharist?)
