



#### WHAT IS THE FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTION?

The First Fridays Devotion, also called the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, is a Catholic devotion to offer reparations for sins. It had its origin in the apparitions of Christ at Paray-le-Monial, France, reported by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. "Nine First Fridays" devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus involves the practice of receiving Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation to "the Heart that has loved men so and is loved so little in return" (Christ's own words to St. Margaret Mary). https://fathersofmercy.com/the-nine-first-fridays-devotion-to-the-most-sacred-heart-of-jesus/


