This weekend we begin our celebration of the liturgical season of Advent as we prepare our hearts for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, both at the end of time and in His Nativity. We welcome Fr. Patrick Baikauskas, O.P., who will preach at all the Masses this weekend and lead us in our Advent Mission on Monday, December 4th (10am, repeated at 7pm) and Tuesday, December 5th (10am, repeated at 7pm). We hope you can join us for one or more of these mission sessions.

Also, please make plans to attend our Advent Reconciliation Service this coming Thursday, December 7th at 7pm. We will have several priests from around the deanery who will be here to assist in hearing confessions. This is a great way to prepare your hearts for our celebration of Christmas and the coming year!

This coming Friday, December 8th is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception which is a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have Masses at 6:30am, 12pm, and 7pm in the Church.

Fr. Patrick Baikauskas, O.P

Fr. Patrick Baikauskas is a Dominican Friar of the Province of St. Albert the Great. He is the Vice President of Institutional Advancement and serves as the Director of the Center for Community Engagement and Evangelization, for the Aquinas Institute of Theology, in St. Louis, Missouri.

Ordained in 2008, Fr. Patrick began serving Saint Thomas Aquinas - The Catholic Center at Purdue University (and the largest parish in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana) for 14 years - 10 years as pastor. The center experiencing exciting growth under his leadership, growing from 200 students actively involved in parish life to nearly 3000. The number of resident parishioners expanded from 250 to 1500. The center also expanded ministry opportunities from less than ten to nearly 50.

In 2016, Pope Francis named him a Missionary of Mercy – an appointment that was recently made permanent. He was named one of 60 priests to serve at preachers for the Eucharistic Revival in the U.S. In addition to his duties at Aquinas, he also serves as a chaplain at the Catholic Student Center at Washington University. Fr. Patrick had a long career in public service, working for several elected officials, including a congressman, three governors, and the President of the United States.

We are excited to welcome Fr. Patrick, to St. Vincent de Paul parish as we begin our Advent journey to more fully open our lives to the true and living presence of our Lord, who came as an infant in Nazareth, who comes to us in the Eucharist, and who will come again to judge the living and the dead.

It is always nice to visit a friend. Friends are there when we need them—to help us, counsel us, support us, and sometimes just listen to us. It is nice to know that friends are there when we need them.

Jesus is like that too. He is there for us in the tabernacle, really and truly. In the celebration of the Holy Mass, Jesus becomes present under the forms of bread and wine. When Mass is over, what is left of the Eucharist is placed in the tabernacle. That means that Jesus is really there for us to visit anytime. God is truly with us. Our friend Jesus is there to help, counsel, support, and just listen. And if we give Jesus some quiet time, he will speak back to us in the depths of our hearts and help us to solve whatever problems or concerns we might have. Just like you do with other friends, give some time to Jesus.

If the sacred liturgy holds first place in the life of the Church, the Eucharistic Mystery stands at the heart and center of the Liturgy. It is the font of life that cleanses us and strengthens us to live not for ourselves but for God and to be united to each other by the closest ties of love.

Immaculate Conception

A common misconception is that the Immaculate Conception refers to Jesus being conceived without Original Sin. In fact, as we see in the full title, Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, it is the Church's belief that the Blessed Virgin Mary was conceived in the usual way BUT was preserved from original sin from the first moment of her conception, "by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin" (CCC 491).

God did this because he had chosen Mary to be the *Theotokos* (God-Bearer), in order to give her divine Son a pure "tabernacle" in Mary's womb. We see hints of this in Scriptures. Elizabeth exclaims, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb!" (Lk 1:42). The angel Gabriel greets Mary with the words, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you" (Lk 1:28).

Grace is a free gift of God enabling us to respond to God's call. Sanctifying grace perfects our soul so that we may live with God and act by God's love (CCC 2000). Through original sin, we lose sanctifying grace. However, God preserved sanctifying grace in Mary from the start. Mary still possessed the gift of free will and chose to say yes to God in the incarnation of her Son, Jesus. She continued to say yes to God in response to God's grace and remained sinless throughout her life.
