

If you want to make any changes to your account or adjust your giving amount, **WeShare** requires a one-time security verification to provide you access. To successfully complete the verification process you will need: Your ParishPay User Name, The last four digits of the bank account or credit card that is currently being used for your donations, and ONE of the following two options: The email you used to register with ParishPay or a collection name and the specific amount donated in the last six months. Once verification is complete, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to our new **WeShare** site. Please bookmark or save this link for future access.
