
# GOD'S LOVE POURED OUT

# SYNOPSIS

"God is love" - 1 John 4:8

This simple statement is the beginning and the ending of our pilgrimage of Faith. God is Love and the Lord's Love is perfect, passionate and unconditional. There is nothing that we can do that would cause God to love us more and nothing we can do that would cause him to love us less. We are able to come to experience the beauty and freedom of God's Love by the Holy Spirit. The Spirit of God reveals the Love of the Father that changes us. When we experience God's Love we come to understand in a powerful way that we are in fact "lovable." God's Love reveals our beauty and goodness before him.

- 1. Fr. Dave says that God's love for us is unconditional. We don't earn or lose God's love. There is nothing you can do to make God love you less and there is nothing you can do to make God love you more.
- -Have you ever felt loved that way by a person? Where were you? How did you feel? -Do you feel that God loves you that way?
- 2. Fr. Dave says we're all like pennies—we all have the same worth in God's eyes, but some of us have been through more, are beat up and dirty and we don't believe we're worthy of being loved.
- -Have you ever felt like that?
- -What does the penny analogy tell us about God's love for you?
- 3. All "love" is not the same. Think about the meaning that today's culture attaches to "love." Compare this to the Love of God.



# KEY TEXTS

**ROMANS 5:5** "The Love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us."

**1 JOHN 4:8-11** "Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love. In this way the love of God was revealed to us: God sent his only Son into the world so that we might have life through him. In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as expiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also must love one another."

**JOHN 4:4-39** The story of the Woman at the Well.



# SYNOPSIS

The only way we are able to live a life of faith, a life full of love, peace, joy and power is by the Holy Spirit. We see this most clearly in the lives of the Apostles. They had every advantage in being with Jesus and hearing him preach and seeing the many miracles that he had done. And yet, even with that advantage they were frightened men living their faith life in a locked room before they received the Holy Spirit. What took place in the upper room changed the lives of these men and women and would change the course of human history. This experience of the Holy Spirit is an encounter available to everyone; it is not reserved for a select few. Pentecost and the transforming power of the Holy Spirit is the theme of this segment.

## REFLECTION

1. What was your image of the Holy Spirit before watching this video? What is your image of the Holy Spirit now?

DISCUSSION

2. Fr. Dave tells us to directly address the Holy Spirit and invite the Spirit into our hearts and the concrete situations of our lives by sampling saying, "Come, Holy Spirit" What would you most like the Holy Spirit to transform in your life? What do you think about asking the Holy Spirit for help?

3. Take three minutes to do some deep breathing. Sit in silence or put on a calming, meditative track. Close your eyes and breathe deeply and slowly. Breathe in the Holy Spirit with each breath. When you're done, follow the steps for the REFLECTION to the right.

Come Holy Spirit.


Prayerfully read over the scriptures cited here. Take some time and ask that God would send you his Holy Spirit and give you peace.

After a few minutes ask that God would breathe life into you and pray that God would send upon you the Holy Spirit just as he did the apostles

centuries ago.

Expect to experience God's peace, presence and love.

Holy Spirit, breath life into these dry bones.

# THE SPIRIT AND OUR LADY SEGMENTA

# SYNOPSIS

"The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will **overshadow** you." - Luke 1:35

Our Lady, from the moment of her conception, was overshadowed by the Holy Spirt. As the Spouse of the Holy Spirit she models for us what our lives can look like when we say "yes" to God's will and fully give ourselves over to the actions of the Spirit of God. Mary's fiat led her to the cross, the empty tomb and ultimately the upper room where she was once again overshadowed by the Holy Spirit. If we have the courage, as Mary did, to say yes to God's Spirit, to surrender our will to his, we too will experience the power of the Most High overshadowing us.

### DISCUSSION

- 1. In the video Sister Maris Stella talks about how she realized "I can't do this alone." She learned that Mary is our example and guide in how to live in the Spirit by saying YES to God's loving invitation in every small moment of the day. What are some examples of how you can say YES to the Spirit in the normal moments of everyday life?
- 2. Fr. Dave shares the story of the Annunciation when Mary asks "How can this be?" Have you ever asked that question in prayer in a time of joy or struggle/confusion?
  - 3. How has God used you to bring about his plan in other people's lives?




Come Holy Spirit.

The same Holy Spirit that overshadowed our Lady desires to overshadow you. Take some time in prayer and consider the role our Lady and the Holy Spirit had in the plan of our salvation.

Pray for the grace to echo Mary's "yes" to the will of the Holy Spirit and pray that Mary would intercede for you.

# OF THE HOLY SPIRI

# SYNOPSIS

The greatest gift of the Holy Spirit is the Holy Spirit. The living God gives the gift of himself to those who are baptized. From the Spirit flows other gifts, some of which are for our personal sanctification while others are for the building up and support of the body of Christ. Many of the gifts are very familiar to us (wisdom, counsel, love) while others are somewhat foreign (healing, prophecy, tongues). Whatever our experience, the gifts of the Holy Spirit are for all Christians, and no one should think that the gifts are not for them.

- 1. Do you know a family member or friend who is so joyful that it makes you wonder why? Can you sense the gifts of the prayer time. For the first couple Holy Spirit in them?
  - 2. Reflect on experiences that you have had where you were aware of the gifts BE DOCILE of the Holy Spirit. What did you experi-AND OPEN ence? Wisdom? For-TO THE SPIRIT titude? Love? Peace? Hope?
  - 3. It is essential that our stance before God is one of being open. What does it look like for you to approach the Lord with an open spirit? Are you open to receiving whatever God wants to give you?
  - 4. Discuss how you see the Holy Spirit being active in the world today.

REFLECTION


Come Holy Spirit.

Take fifteen minutes of personal of minutes do your best to quiet yourself; give to God whatever distractions you may have. Ask

God to bring to life the

gifts of the Holy Spirit that are present in you: the gifts received at baptism as well as new gifts with which God may want to bless you. Be open - let God

bless and anoint you. In the following days and weeks pray for a sensitivity to the movement of the Holy Spirit. It may be in a nudge to call someone, to encourage someone. Someone may share with you that he or she is ill or has a loved one who is struggling; at that moment stop and pray for that person.


