From the Desk of Fr. Ricardo

The region of Galilee was a difficult place to be alone. The area was 50 miles North to South and 24 miles East to West. There were 201 towns and villages, and none of them had a population of fewer than 15,000 people.

Jesus needed to be alone. He had just heard of the death of John the Baptist by King Herod. He was under great stress. He was tired. In His full humanity, Jesus was not immune to the natural response of anxiety. Never reckless, He took precautions to remove Himself from Herod's notice. He knew that the Cross was coming closer and closer, but He knew that it would come when it would come. He also knew that He needed to meet with God before He met with more men and their needs.

These past few months of physical and emotional demands on us caused by the pandemic and the anxiety of financial instability, have caused many of us to experience that strong human insistence to seek rest for body and strength for soul. Like Jesus, we can't seem to get it. The crowd followed Him to His refuge, so He responded with compassion. He healed and fed them.

This event shows us Jesus being moved by compassion to the depths of His being. He did not resent the people or their demands. He abandoned His longing for privacy. Jesus never dealt with people with one eye on the clock. God cares. So must we.

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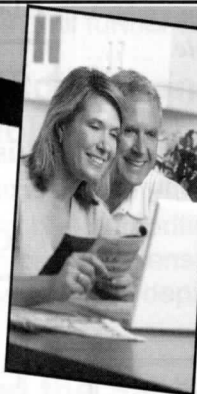
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
