In The Dark of Night

Today's Gospel by Saint Matthew reads like a short story. Jesus walks on the waters of the Sea of Galilee. Three hours before dawn — "the fourth watch of the night". It had been a full day. Five thousand men, plus women and children had followed Jesus into the open countryside. There in the late afternoon, on the slopes above the seashore, He had fed them all with bread and fish.

Afterward, Jesus sent the crowds back to their ordinary lives. He ordered His disciples to get into their boat and cross over to the other side of the sea. He stayed alone and headed up into the hills to pray.

In the meantime, the disciples ran into a storm. In the darkness and the wind, Jesus came walking toward them on the water. He said, Take courage. It is I. Do not be afraid. Jesus assumes that the opposite of faith is not unbelief but fearfulness, anxiety, timidity, or paralyzing dread.

The disciples have lost control, directionless. They are out of their depths. Then Peter makes a strange request: Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water. Jesus answers, Come.

There are very few of us who have not wakened at "the fourth watch" from a deep sleep and immediately fallen into confusion and worry about the future.

Fears overwhelm us. Over the dark waters of our fragile humanity, listen for the call, Come, I am with you. Take courage.
