### Mean What You Say

Today's parable highlights Jesus' invitation and acceptance of sinners and outcasts. More than that, it invites us to pay attention to two words that govern and direct our lives: "yes "and "no". What makes the difference in our lives is not the words themselves, but the spirit in which they are said. They can be said without thinking, or they can be said thoughtfully. What really matters is if we have acted upon them.

There is a part of each son in us. Sometimes our actions do not always match our promises. We give our word but do not always keep it. We turn our "yes" to "no". It is easy to say "yes" because we do not always know what is involved in the task to which we are committing ourselves.

Many of the saints in the Church were sinners who had said no to God and then later changed their minds and became heroic men and women. St. Augustine is a classic example. A person is not judged by a single response or even a phase of his or her life but by the whole of life.

How does today's parable challenge us? With which son do we identify? Do we strive to keep our word no matter what? God gives us the freedom to say "yes" or "no". Sometimes we commit with words but not deeds. The important thing is constant self-examination. We must say what we mean and mean what we say.




