

We live in a skeptical society. Skepticism results in being unable to trust one another. Some people will only believe that which they can prove themselves. Some put feelings before facts and will only agree with what they feel good about. This is worrying. Experience tells us that we cannot always trust our feelings. When Jesus speaks with authority, we know Him to be compassionate, but He doesn't replace facts with feelings. In banishing an unclean spirit from a possessed man, Jesus is restoring that man to a fuller life. He is enabling Him to take his place in his community. When Jesus shows that He has a greater authority than the scribes and the unclean spirits, He is bringing forth His Father from whom HIs authority

In the first reading from Deuteronomy, Moses prophesies that someone like himself will be raised up, and God will put His words into His mouth. So, Jesus' listeners would have recognized Him as the fulfillment of a prophecy. The authority of the scribes was based on the Law of Moses. This would now be superseded by one who has authority from God - by the Author of the Law. Jesus has authority and the power that goes with it.

God-given authority is backed up by merciful action. When we teach and preach to our suspicious age, what we say has to be well-reasoned and factually correct. It has to be demonstrated by what we say and how we act. It cannot be cold and heartless but must touch those who hear so that they come closer to the Authority who gives them life.
