Flowers for Mary





From time to time, we have all probably asked ourselves what it would have been like to live in the time of the gospels and see Jesus face-to-face. This is where today's gospel comes in. The Greeks who say to Phillip, We wish to see Jesus, say this not only in their name but also on behalf of all those who throughout history, have not been able to see Him in the flesh. The Greeks speak for all of us.

When Jesus hears that some Greeks are wishing to see Him. His answer is directed to all who have or will ever wish to see Him. Up to this point in the ministry of Jesus, we repeatedly hear, My hour has not yet come. Now things change, Jesus says: the hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

After years of preaching and miraculous signs, the Passion of the Christ begins.

What triggers this momentous change? Some anonymous Greeks wish to see Jesus. The whole mission of Jesus was that He should be seen. He needed to be seen by the Jewish people and by the whole wider world which the Greeks represent.

Christ is not a celebrity; He is the source of eternal life. We don't long to see Him with the eyes of idle curiosity but with eyes of faith. It is that vision of faith that saves us from our sins, and seeing God in eternity is our reward of eternal salvation. It is the news that the world is ready to see Him that triggers the saving work of Christ: His Passion and Death.

And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself.






