The Gift of Hope

Today we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord. This day falls halfway between the shortest day of the year and the spring equinox. Winter is beginning to release its grip, but there is little sign of spring. It is quietly slipping towards light, warmth, and new growth.

In Rembrandt's painting of this scene, the temple is a vast, gloomy building. A little group including the Holy Family is bathed in light, but the crowd is unaware. The Lord comes as an ordinary baby. He is just like all the other babies. How is it that two old people spot Him?

Simeon and Anna had lived through the long winter of God's apparent absence but did not despair. Carl Jung once said that if the old live in the past, they die before their death. But if their eyes are open to the future, they are wonderfully alive even as death approaches.

Simeon and Anna let themselves be surprised. If we keep our eyes open and let God surprise us, We will not worry that the world calls our time "the post-Christian era." In the Preface of the Mass for Holy Men and Women, we hear: You renew the Church in every age by raising up men and women outstanding in holiness.

There are babies and young people among us now who will be the new saints. They are probably already with us. God is always working in salvation history. When our time comes, we can depart in peace.
