Why Pentecost?

For Christians, Pentecost is that day the Holy Spirit descended on Our Lady and on the disciples in the upper room. Yet, in John's Gospel, it is clear that Jesus is already imparting the Spirit before that event.

The center of Christian theology is the unity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit as revealed by Jesus: the mystery of the Blessed Trinity. It is the most important article of our Faith and the truth which guides us as we read the gospels.

Jesus provides us with the model of a true human community as He imparts the Spirit. The Father is always united with Jesus because Jesus is His Son, His Word. In the same way, the Spirit, too, is always united with the Son. Whenever Jesus spoke or acted, He was imparting the Holy Spirit.

Jesus instructed His disciples to baptize all nations and to love one another. He was molding them into a community bound by particular values and nourished by the love of God at work in them.

St. Augustine tells us that a community is united by the things it loves, the values that its members share. Unfortunately, in our time, many people live very private lives motivated by individualistic values.

Pentecost is necessary for a perfect community. The presence of the Holy Spirit within each one of us binds us in perfect love. Community keeps building by communicating the merciful love of God to our society and the whole world.
