It's a Mystery

People sometimes say that our Christian Faith is a leap into the dark. We are accused of letting go of rational knowledge and venturing into darkness.

Mystery in our Faith does not mean that we are faced with the kind of puzzle that faces a scientist. To consider mystery in a Christian sense is to stop thinking that we cannot see because we have leaped into the darkness. We cannot see the entire depth of mystery, not because it is dark, but because there is too much light for our weak eyes.

Faith is having our eyes strengthened and opened by God. By God, we learn about His life as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and about our sharing in the divine life of the Holy Trinity. A life of persons in love.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the mystery of those three Persons in love. It is deep. And the mystery of the Trinity graciously and marvelously choosing to share that love with us is also deep. If we celebrate the Holy Trinity using only our natural knowledge, we have ignored the issue. Every human person is a mystery, so is love. Imagine the depth of divine love.

Today's Gospel says: I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. The history of salvation is identical with God revealing Himself to us. We are not alone. We are in a relationship of light. Don't feel lost. Be lost in wonder.
