The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul brings together two giants of the Church at its very beginning. Their mission took them on different paths to the city of Rome, where the mission to all the nations would find its center, and where, both Peter and Paul, would be united to Christ in a death like his.

In our readings, we learn how the wonderful grace of God has given Peter and Paul extraordinary and miraculous experiences for the fulfillment of their ministries. Peter is unlocked from prison; Paul is saved many times from shipwreck. The Lord has given Peter the keys of the kingdom, to bind and loose on earth and in heaven. Ultimately, in the Lord's providence, He does not save them from ignominious deaths like His, but they share in it willingly – a short distance from one another, united in the Lord.

If we're tempted to judge the weakness of Peter and the arrogance of Paul, we might reflect on our own moments of conversion and our own confessions of faith. We wish to see God as He really is – that's His promise, that's His gift. Once we change our hearts and lift our minds, we are loosened to enjoy a new vision. It is we ourselves who bind ourselves when we remain in the darkness. It is our duty to encourage one another to glory in the cross of Christ, and urge each other to behold the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Ministry of Eucharistic Visitors

Before the COVID disaster, our Parish had a Ministry of Eucharistic Visitors. These people visited the nursing homes in the area and brought the Blessed Sacrament to isolated and lonely people. I believe that it is time to renew that commitment, and I invite as many of you as possible to join me in forming such a group.

Through our current monthly catechesis, many Parishioners have been trying to heighten their understanding of the place of the Eucharist in our lives. Many of you have a great devotion to adoration. Some of you are just discovering the power of intimacy with Jesus through frequent Communion. We are all incorporated into the Church through Baptism, the reception of Holy Communion renews, strengthens, and deepens our Faith because we abide with Jesus through the Eucharist. Imagine the benefit we receive.

Keeping Sacred Space Sacred

We have a predicament. Lately, we have experienced a housekeeping problem. We find crumbs, bits of crackers, and even used water bottles left in pews. We remind parishioners that as an act of reverence for the importance of the reception of the Blessed Sacrament, we fast from food and drink one hour before communion. This simple custom allows us to promote an attitude of attention and respect for the importance of the Eucharist.

If someone has a health issue requiring specific timing for food, or a mother has a toddler who can only be controlled with a snack, that is, of course, understandable. In such a case, we ask that you do so discreetly and that you take a moment to clean up any leftovers in consideration for the next person to use your pew and to avoid luring mice into a sacred space. No one else should be eating in church.

It is always a good time to teach our children and to remind ourselves of the Sacredness of the Divine Presence in our Church. St. Thomas Aquinas called the Eucharist the perfect sign of the Passion of Christ. In his magnificent hymns, especially the Pange Lingua, he recommended the utmost physical and spiritual awareness we owe to God for this greatest of gifts.
